Francisco and Norbert Payton in Oakland. We never get too practice handoffs."

Embarrassing. That's the only way to describe Steve Williams' performance in the 100 meters, a race created ostensibly to give him a chance at the world record.

The 19-year-old New Yorker came out of the blocks badly. After having gained some ground, he lost control of his form midway through the race and finished third. Herb Washington, who Williams overhauled at Fresno, won in 10.1 with Ivory Crockett second at 10.2, Williams' time.

"It was my own fault," Williams said. "I just messed up. I don't know what I thought. I'll tell you it won't happen again. I won't stop running until I see the curve."

Having taken "25 hard throws" in practice the day before, shotputter Al Feuerbach was well satisfied with his 70-10 performance. It broke Randy Matson's three-year-old meet record and was the fourth best mark ever, trailing only his own pending world record and two by Matson.

"I felt I had a lot of poten-

tial today," Feuerbach said, "which was kind of surprising. There are training weeks and training weeks when you point for competition and this was one of my tougher workout weeks in a while."

UCLA's James McAlister upset Olympic champion Randy Williams for the second time this year, 26-7½ to 26-5½ in the long jump. The

CCSF Wins State Track, Field Crown

BAKERSFIELD — City College of San Francisco captured its first State Junior College track championship since 1957 and the second in the school's history last night.

Los Angeles City College placed second, with Bakersfield third, Mt. San Antonio fourth and Foothill and Grossmont in a tie for fifth. Official point totals were not expected to be available until this morning.

In the featured 880-yard run, Laney's James Robinson turned in a slower time than expected but still won in 1:51.5. CCSF's Cirilo Morgan was second in 1:52.1.

Middies Grab IC4A Track Title

NEW BRUNSWICK (N.J.) — (AP) — Navy scored 41 points and won its first team title since 1946 in the 97th IC4A track and field championships yesterday at Rutgers University.

Coached by Jim Gehrdes, the Middies wound up with 41 points.

Scott Harney was the lone winner of the day for the new champions. He took the shot at 60 feet, 11½ inches.

Penn, the defending champion, wound up in fifth place with 24 points. Maryland and Penn State shared the runnerup spot with 29½ points and Manhattan was fourth with 26.

Three meet records were shattered.

Villanova's John Hartnett ran his first steeplechase and took the 3,000-meter title in 8:54.2 to become the two-day meet's only double winner. He had won the six-miles Friday.
