

Larrieu Lowers Record

HAYWARD — Olympian Francie Larrieu set an American record in the two-mile Sunday to lead the San Jose Cindergals to the team title in the Pacific Association Women's track and field championships.

Francie, the 20-year-old DeAnza College coed who Saturday won the women's mile at the Kennedy Games at Berkeley, negotiated the eight laps in 10:02.8 and was one of two individual winners for the Cindergals.

Cindergal Diane Dimmick won the one-mile walk in 8:45.5 and San Jose's only other first place came in the two-mile relay.

The Cindergal "A" team won the relay in 9:28.2, 15 seconds faster than their runnerup "B" quartet.

Eileen Claugus, of the Wills Spikettes, was the only double winner Sunday, claiming the 880 in 2:15.0 and the mile in 4:55.5.

Olympian Francie Larrieau, competing for the San Jose Cindergals, broke the American two mile record by five seconds with a ten-minute, 2.8 second clocking yesterday in the PA-AAU Women's Track and Field Championships at Cal Hayward.
