philosophy. I just beat Matson's record by a lousy 1½ inches. If I said I was satisfied it wouldn't say much for my guts and determination.

"Now I'm going to train even harder and try to accelerate the record past the rest of the field. I want to be the greatest shot putter in the world."

Besides breaking the world record, Feuerbach unconsciously pressured John Powell, his Pacific Coast Club teammate and San Jose policeman.

"Al and I sort of have a bet," said Powell, who responded with a 1973 world best of 218-7 in the discus. "If three was any day to set a world record in a major meet, today was the day."

"Feuerbach created a little more pressure than I wanted. I wasn't competing against anyone but him. I'm not satisfied."

Steve Smith, another PCC member, was so wrapped up in Feuerbach's record that

he forgot about the pole vault and passed until 17-2, which he cleared. Former world record holder Kjell Isaksson failed in three attempts at the same height.
