Stanford Rip Oxy In Track

STANFORD - Sweeping the shot put, discus and triple jump and receiving a sprint double by Ken Curl, Stanford rolled to a 100-54 victory over Occidental before 1500 fans in Stanford Stadium Saturday afternoon.

Marks were hampered by gusty winds which worked against the runners and also bothered discus and javelin throwers and pole vaulters.

Cardinal freshman Terry Albritton led the sweep in the shot with a meet record throw of 59-9. He was followed by Ralph Bakkenson and Pete Dreissigacker who tossed their seasonal bests of 51-9 and 47-11, respectively.

Jim Howard, Jim Royer and Dreissigacker went one-two-three in the discus for the Cardinals, and Rod Utley made his 1973 debut for Stanford with an impressive 49-3 in the triple jump. Mel Ho was second at 46-4 and Derek Toliver third at 45-53/4, both marks being '73 bests.

Curl took the 100 in 9.9 while bucking a wind, and the 220 in 21.8.

The best race of the day developed in the two mile as Stanford's Mark McConnell held off the challenge of Oxy yearling Joel Jameson as both were timed in 9:03.6. It was McConnell's personal best, and Jameson clipped over 15 seconds off his previous best. It's a Occidental frosh record for Jameson, former Watsonville prepster.

"I'm very pleased," stated Stanford coach Payton Jordan. "We jelled as a team after dead week and then a week of vacation. "We weren't sharp in all areas, but there were a lot of good things.

"McConnell's two mile has to be the highlight as he turned in his personal best and scored a gutsy win.

"Curl looked smooth and steady, and Utley's impressive return is a big boost for

The victory evened Stanford's record with Oxy at 6-6 since Jordan moved from Occidental as the Cards' head coach in 1957.
