

Varsity charge downs soccer alumni, 7-2

Overcoming an early lead, the Aztec Varsity soccer squad scored seven consecutive goals, and posted a convincing 7-2 win over the Aztec Alumni in the annual Red-Black soccer tilt Saturday.

It looked as though the Alumni were going to be a problem for the younger Aztecs, as they jumped out to a quick 2-0 lead in the first 15 minutes of play.

"We didn't play well in the first half," said Varsity coach George Logan. "Both of the Alumni's goals came from our defense."

But that was all the Alumni were to get, as the Varsity shut out their opponents the rest of the way, and in the process scored seven goals of their own, five of them in the second half.

"We just blew them (Alumni) off the field in the second half," said Logan.

Allan Kelly led the Varsity scoring with three goals.

Women spikers excel

Giving valiant performances in the javelin, high jump, 100-meter hurdles and the 440-yard relay events were four members of the Aztec women's intercollegiate track and field team who traveled in May to Denton, Texas to compete in the National Women's Intercollegiate Track and Field Championships.

Held at Texas Woman's University, the national event included 84 schools in which the Aztecs placed 22nd.

The Aztec placing the highest was javelin specialist Vicki Hallman, who brought home fifth place honors with a throw of 144 feet. The winning throw of 166' 2" was by a California State University, Hayward member.

Aztec Cami Conly's performance in the high jump gave her a sixth

place with a leap of 5'5". Miss Conly then grabbed another sixth place in the 100-meter hurdles with a time of 14.9 seconds. The winning time for the event was 13.9 seconds given by a member of the Prairie View A & M team.

The Aztec 440-yard relay team of Misses Hallman, Conly, Noreen Cicchetto and Wanda Greenfield placed 11th in the event.

Two other Southern California schools, both of which compete in the Aztecs' league, gave sterling performances which landed them positions in the top five in overall team points.

The Bruins of UCLA grabbed second place national honors while California State University, Los Angeles won a fourth place national berth.
