# Record assaults have just begun

As the Olympic motto says, in Latin: "Citius, Altius. Fortius."

"That's how it's going to be." said Payton Jordan of Stanford in the wake of the highly successful 11th annual Examiner Games. "They're going to be running faster, throwing farther, jumping farther and higher, you can be sure."

George Woods' mighty world indoor record shot put of 70-41/2 is only a sample of things to come in the arena of track and field, the Cardinals' and 1968 (at Mexico) USA Olympic coach predicted.

Payt, in accord with almost everyone else in Friday night's Cow Palace crowd of 13,822, thought it was "a whale of a meet."

"That shot putting was something," Jordan said. "But weren't those South Africans (miler Fannie Van Ziil and 600-yard dashman Marcello Fiasconaro) sensational?

"How do you like a guy like that (Miruts) Yifter, that darned little Ethiopian, turning on the speed and blasting out like he did on the last 320 yards (2 laps) after running almost two miles."

Incidentally, credit where credit's due. For a 57 year old. Jordan was no slouch in the meet as he defended his senior 60-vard dash laurels and equalled his own event record of 7.1 seconds in the doing.

He wasn't alone in the record manufacturing. In addition to Woods' effort. which wiped out everything indoors. Examiner Games marks were set by Fiasconaro (600), Kjell Isaksson (vault), Martha Watson (long jump), Laney J.C.'s sprint medley relay team, St. Ignatius High's sprint medley relay combine and by the Richmond Half Steppers and Salinas Valley TC's tiny-tot baton teams.

Relating to Woods, Jordan said he suspected something big on the giant's third toss. "He staved with the shot to the ultimate of perfectly coordinated movement in both the upper and lower parts of his body," Jordan noted.

"Many times, the big guys try to pop the ball prematurely with the upper part of the body. Because they feel so strong, they think they can do it all upstairs.

"Not so. The best stuff comes out of the legs."

Wood's throw Friday of 70-41/2 ranks the fifth best of all time, indoors or outdoors; according to Track and Field's demon statistician, Don Steffens.

In order, the top ones are: Al Feuerbach's 71-7 (0), Randy Matson's 71-51/2 (0), West German Hartmut Briesenick's 71-11/4 (o) and pro Brian Oldfield's 70-101/2 (i).

In addition to his portable TV set and an Examiner Games champion's gold medallion. Woods took away the Outstanding Performer trophy again.

That made it four straight OPs for the shot putters and eight out of 11 for field event men. Interesting is that the first shot putter to win an OP trophy was former. Oregon star Neal Steinhauer, in 1967. and he, too, set a then-world indoor mark.
