

DISTANCE RECORDS FALL

Community colleges at opposite ends of the country have accounted for two new national distance records. Also, Skyline is claimant to the initial record in the one mile intermediate hurdle relay (3:46.3). And Essex (NJ) has once again lowered the sprint medley record--to 3:18.4. All were set in races against senior colleges.

Allegheny of Pittsburgh, Pa. put together a 17:00.2 four-mile relay April 13 at the Nittany Lions Relays at Penn.St. Philadelphia TC won the race in 16:53.4, ahead of Penn St. (16:58) with Allegheny third; freshmen Charles Schmiedlin (4:15.2), John Jennings (4:15.4) plus sophs Paul Stemmer (4:12.6) and Pat Rexroat (4:17.0) running in that order. They eclipsed by just .2 the 17:00.4 by Los Angeles Valley in 1969.

Kurt Beckman of Spokane CC (Wash.) ran a 28:51.0 six-mile during an all-comers meet at University of Washington in Seattle, Feb. 23. That erased the 28:53.4 mark by Mark Covert of Los Angeles Valley in the 1970 Southern Pacific Assoc. AAU championships at Eagle Rock, Calif. Covert was a member (4:17.1) of that former four-mile relay until too.

Skyline, located just south of San Francisco, provided host Stanford's competition during an attempt on the one mile hurdle record April 17 and established a JC standard for other teams to shoot at. Stanford clocked 3:37.8 to eclipse Occidental's world mark while Skyline's 3:46.3 clocking came from Tom Swartzell (57.5), Ike Allmond (57.3), Bart Pierce (57.3) and Jim Wyatt (54.2).

Essex CC took .5 off its own pending medley mark at the Penn.Relays April 27 with Horace Tuitt anchoring in 1:47.7.

BULLETIN--ROBINSON GETS 880 RECORD

Laney College soph James Robinson erased the oldest standing national JC record with a 1:48.4 clocking for the 880 during the Golden Gate Conference Finals on his home track in Oakland, May 3.

Ray Van Asten of Mt. San Antonio set the old mark of 1:48.6 in the Mt. SAC Relays at Walnut, April 28, 1962. Bob Hose of San Diego Mesa still has the all-time JC best of 1:48.3, run in the National AAU championships in San Diego, June 26, 1965--after school had closed.

Robinson's time is the fastest half by an American collegian this year. He split 52.7 at the 440 and 1:19.5 at the 660 and pulled Gary McManus of Diablo Valley (1:52.7) and George Manriques of San Jose (1:52.8) to the No. 2 and 3 JC times of the season.

Karl Farmer of LA Southwest, who last year equaled Lee Evans' all-time JC 440 best of 45.8, posted the fastest quarter of the 1974 JC season, 47.4 and doubled in the 220 (21.3) in the Southern California Conference Finals.

Mesa Arizona's Ron Semkiw threw the discus 181-4 at Casa Grande, April 27.
