Jenner Takes Decathlon in U.S.S.R.

MOSCOW, Aug. 5 (AP)—Bruce Jenner of the United States won an international decathlon competition at Tallin with 8,308 points, Tass, the Soviet press agency reported today.

But Jan Lember, the runner-up with 7,865 points, led the Soviet Union to a team victory against United States' athletes. The U.S.S.R. had 46,812 points; the United States, 46,309; and West Germany, 45,471.

Other American finishers were Steve Gough, eighth with 7,789 points; Fred Samara, 12th with 7,622; John Workentin, 13th with 7,615; Ron Wanamaker, 16th with 7,494; and Mitchell Hill, 20th with 7,303.
