# UCLA WINS IN A RUNAWAY

## Williams Clocked in 9.3 and 20.7... Eased Up

While San Diego State's Steve Williams breezed to 9.3 and 20.7 sprint victories Saturday, UCLA showed off enough new talent to establish the Bruins as serious contenders for their fourth straight NCAA track and field title this year.

UCLA scored 90 points to win a three-way meet at Drake Stadium, followed by Arizona with 57 and San Diego State with 32. In dual meet scoring, UCLA defeated Arizona, 87-53, and San Diego State, 106-38.

Most impressive of the new Bruins was Clarence Taylor, 21-year-old junior college transfer from St. Louis, who won the triple jump with a lifetime best of 53-11 1/4.

Taylor, a 6-4, 180-pound junior, smashed the stadium record of 53-1, held by former Bruin Harry Freeman.

Other lifetime bests were recorded by freshmen Jerry Hearndon, winner of the long jump at 25-7 1/4, and Jim Neidhart, third in the shot put at 59-11 1/4.

Hearndon, last year's State high school champion Cajon, came through on his last jump to beat National AAU indoor champion Jerry Proctor of the Beverly Hills Striders. The Striders competed as a non-scoring entry.

Neidhart, from Newport Harbor, finished behind teammates Roger Freberg (60-7) and Dave Schiller (59-11 3/4).

"Actually," coach Jim Bush said, "our shot putters are probably a little disappointed, because you should see what they've been doing in practice."

Bush, summing up the meet, said, "Obviously we don't have the team we had last year. We don't have any hurdlers and we're pretty thin on the track. We could be in trouble in dual meets.

"But it looks like we're going to have the big meet points. When the championship meets roll around, we're going to make somebody sweat."  
In the sprints, Williams

admittedly was under wraps. He was the last man out of the blocks in the 100 but easily caught the field at 40 yards, then free-wheeled into the tape. He also eased up in the 220.

"I didn't try to get out of the blocks," he said. "It was kinda cold and I didn't want to push it. It's still early. Right now I'm more concerned about my studies."

### Track Notes

Williams didn't run either relay. UCLA's **Benny Brown** didn't run the 440, won by San Diego State's **James Redd** in a photo over UCLA's **Maxie Parks** in 46.4. Bush said, "I didn't want Benny and Maxie going head-to-head this early" . . . UCLA's **Francois Tracanelli** quit after winning the pole vault at 16-0. He had a cramp in his leg . . . Sprinter **Gordon Peppers** got a cramp in the 440 relay and called it a day . . . UCLA's **Rory Kotinek** had a foul throw of 218 feet in the javelin. "But he's been doing better than that in practice," Bush said. "The Tartan runway was slipping today, causing a lot of fouls."

Arizona's **Ed Arriola**, from Gahr High, was a revelation, winning the mile in 4:05.4 and the 800 in 1:51.2, lifetime bests. In the half, UCLA freshman **Curtis Beck** pushed Arriola until the final turn, then steadily dropped back and gave away second to teammate **Tom Kovacich** . . . Freberg, in the shot, employed a discus-style technique, doing a full turn in the ring before casting off. There might be something to it. Freberg had his lifetime best.
