April Fools Day 74

All you need do is look outside to know that another track season has begun. The weather last week was so bad that some athletes in Cheney balked at removing sweats in the 40 degrees, 25-mile-an-hour wind and drenching rain. Imagine! A high-school meet in Medical Lake was called off because of the combination of cold, wind and water.

High schools just are beginning to get serious about the 74 season. Spokane schools had their first meets last week, then will take this week off for spring break. Some westside schools have been busy -- Seattle Prep already has been in 5 meets -- and good marks were produced at the first Shoreline Community College Invitational a week and a half ago, when the sun happened to be shining, and at the Daffodil Relays, held on a typical blustery, numbing day last Saturday at Spanaway.

The first serious, big gathering will be a week hence at Pasco for the Pasco Invite April 13.

Lincoln's Keith Tinner opened his season in a dual a couple weeks ago with 22.0/49.5, probably the first sub-50 quarter ever run in this state in March. But Lincoln is taking a back seat now in Tacoma to Wilson, where first-year-coach Jim Daulley has a powerful squad. Amid all the good Rams, the star may turn out to be junior Harold Celms, who opened with a casual 4:22.6. That was the mile leader until Bothell's Dan Buttle ran a sudden 4:19.5 PR in a dual on a lousy day.

The most surprising early news has come from super-athlete Dean Pedigo, apparently headed for WSU to play linebacker, who has opened the year with 174-6/173-3 in the disc. He is 1 of 3 Everett throwers already over 160.

Mt. Tahoma's Oscar Chambers opened with a 46-1 legal tj. Since then, Jerry Merz of Highline hit a windy 46-6 3/4. Bad weather has hurt the vaulters, but Ron Clausen still has managed 14-2 3/4 to take an old record away from Brian Sternberg. State champ Duran Wooten was upset in the 100 by Queen Anne's Greg Griffin. The District 10 sprints figure to be sensational with Wooten(9.6w/22.1), Griffin(10.0), Mark DeSalvo(9.8w/22.3), soph Garland Watkins and Larron Patton(22.2), returning to Garfield after a year's injury. Watkins, at Seattle Prep, already this season has dashed 10.0/22.2.

Teamwise, the early impressive teams are: AAA--Lincoln, Wilson & Clover Park; AA--Franklin Pierce and East Valley/Spokane(Shelton no meets yet); A--Woodland, Langley, Oakesdale.

C O L L E G E S

One of the most important dual meets in University of Washington track history takes place this Saturday in Husky Stadium when a young, audacious UW team meets prestigious Oregon. The Ducks, no longer under the firm hand of Bill Bowerman, will need every ounce of legend they can find to defeat a Husky squad that, it appears, is unafraid.

Washington geared for the meet by trouncing Idaho, Montana and Club Northwest last Saturday. That day in Eugene, Oregon had its hands full with Arizona State, 84-70.

Washington State had a dual with Cal postponed by rain. The Cougars are scheduled to meet San Jose in California Saturday. That meet could feature another 6-mile assault by John Ngeno -- who said, after he ran 27:20(11th-fastest in history) in Seattle in March, that he can break 27 minutes.

The indoor season closed with a rush with new national records by Jan Johnson's little brother, Tim(Bloom Township Ill.), 16-7; Noel Ruebel, Highland, Ind., 7-0(first prep indoor 7-footer); North-Terre Haute, Ind., 17:29.6 4-mile relay; Lane Tech-Chicago 3:19.5 mile relay, breaking a 35-year-old record, and Ken McClendon(Washington-Denver) 51-9 3/4 to defeat Don Duvall(Coronado-Colorado Springs) by 3". But the most shocking indoor news was by Rudy Chapa, a soph from Hammond, Ind., who ran 8:57.0 and 8:55.8 -- already taking away from super-soph Eric Hulst a class record.

Outdoors, Bill Blessing(Hillcrest-Dallas) blasted the 330 intermediates in 35.9 to take that record away from Bob Bornkessel. Blessing, who also has run a windy 13.4, reportedly is being recruited heavily by USC & UCLA(which means he must be good, huh?). Quarter has begun good with 4 already under 48. Collins, 880 leader, ran his 1:53.2 in his first try ever at the distance.

Dyrk Dahl, 1:53 freshman last year, has moved from Oklahoma to Fountain, Colo., where his father is stationed at Camp Carson. His pa, John, is a former Big 8 champ in the 440 for Oklahoma U. Tim Roberts, a top hurdler in Colorado, is the son of Eddie Roberts, past Big 8 champ at Oklahoma State.

This year's Golden West has been moved back a week to June 22. June: 8--International Prep, Mt. Prospect, Ill. 14-15--National AAU Juniors, Gainesville, Fla. 22--Golden West(& National AAU, UCLA) 28-29--US/USSR Juniors, Austin, Tex. The All-American prep meet has been canceled.

With the conclusion of the indoor season and the onset of the outdoor season, a raft of quality marks have been produced by the collegiate and open athletes of the state. We currently have no less than three national leaders; Fred Luke of Club Northwest who has flung the jav 267-6 and 271-2 in his only two outings this far into the season; Dale Fleet of WSU ran an amazing 8:37.8 steeple in his first college effort in miserable conditions; and John Ngeno who has been running sensationally indoors and out with his 27:20.4 six-mile. Indoors, Greg Gibson of Washington, plans to concentrate on the mile this season and has already produced 3:59.1 behind Tony Waldrops indoor record 3:55.0. In the same meet, Jim Johnson of CNW followed Steve Prefontaine's American Indoor record of 8:20.4 with 8:30.0, the best ever by a Washingtonian, bettering Gerry Lindgren's 8:31.61. Johnson also ran 27:52.8 behind Ngeno in the six. Ngeno won the NCAA Indoor 3M over a good field with 13:20.8.

Lee Braach improved his PR to 7-1 $\frac{1}{4}$ in his debut in Pullman. Kurt Beckman of Spokane CC narrowly missed the JC six-mile mark with his 28:51.0 to beat a good field at the Shoreline all-comers in late February. Russ Vincent has upped his shot PR several times already this spring, finally to 57-11 at the Easter Relays, Washington had a surprising second in that meet, beating Oregon, California and Stanford. Speaking of Oregon, they will be hard put to put down the surprising Huskies in their dual in Seattle on Saturday. Oregon is even threatend with the possibility of going 0-3 in Northern Division dual meets as both WSU and Oregon State look very tough.

One of the biggest track stories does not involve any kind of a record. Lucas Oloo of Spokane Falls CC has suddenly transferred to Oregon State in a very messy situation. Oloo had made commitments to his coaches and teammates only to not show for a meet March 23rd at Spokane CC. He finally turned up in a Corvallis dormitory with Beaver coach Berny Wagner saying he would be enrolled and eligible immediately. Wagner had told Les Rurey, SFCC coach, he was going after Oloo, but only told him after the fact in the transfer.

Oh yes, how can we forget the tremendous victory of Steve Gough over decathlon record holder Nikolay Avilov of the USSR in the pentathlon. Steve opened with a 8.0 high hurdle time for 60m behind Avilov's 7.8. Then, Avilov won the HJ 6-7 to 6-6. Gough won the LJ with 24-0 $\frac{1}{2}$ and the shot with a PR 51-6 $\frac{1}{2}$. He then was 2nd to teammate Fred Samara in the 500m with 1:08.5 to 1:07.0. Jim Johnson again followed a good pace to record an American record for 5000m with 13:56.4 for 3rd behind the two Russians. That gives Jim 8:30.0(2M)/13:56.4m/ and 27:52.8 for '74 and all non-winning. He has yet to run his best event, the steeple.

BITS AND PIECES

Gibson's 3:59.1 is #4 on the US all-time juniors list. He trails Jim Ryun(3:51.3), Jerry Ritchie(3:58.6), Mark Schilling(3:53.7) and equals Roscoe Divine...Brian Mittlestadt is now at UPS from Stanford but will be ineligible for the NCAA meet. Brian says "Now I can enjoy running again," referring to the PAC-8 pressure...Clary Reinsma ran about 29:30 in the Easter Relays six-mile...Wendell Brown, former grad assistant at UW is now coaching in Nigeria...John Ngeno is now 3rd all-time college in the 6M, behind Pre and Lingren...Siggi Busha is still at Texas but has not thrown yet due to a bad elbow...Dave Herald of WSU suffered another

muscle pull and may not run the rest of the season, after missing most of last year with the same kind of injury...John Hayes, HJ frosh at UW suffered a hairline fracture in his foot(not the takeoff foot) and is expected to miss two weeks...

Club Northwest will have as impressive an IH crew as anyone in the country if Boyd Gittins, Geoff Vanderstock, and Ralph Mann show past form... Rick Riley is training but is troubled by the tendon problem he has had for years...SFCC not only lost Oloo, but may be facing the end of their entire track program due to budget cuts... Tom Gregerson and Gary Quitslund, both fine JT men, have left the UW team...Brian Mondschein has a severe ankle sprain and will miss the whole season...Brad Nave, former DT man from Whitworth is now at Hayward(Cal.) State using his last year of eligibility...Bill Hicks ran a 47.9r in the UW-Occidental meet...The WSU-Cal dual was postponed from March 30 to April 1 due to "wet grounds" (that's no April Fool's joke either!)...The April 13 WSU-Oregon State dual will have no less than 5 7-foot HJ'ers with Tom Woods, Mike Fleer, Lee Braach, Bob Niehl, and Al Darnielle...The mile in the Ore-UW meet could be sensationally with Greg Gibson(3:59.1i), Rick Albright(4:03.2/3:43.2m), Mark Feig(3:59.4), and Scott Daggatt(3:59.6). Throw in Jim Johnson of CNW as a guest (3:58.8) and you have excellent chance to break the venerable meet record 4:00.3 by Keith Forman.

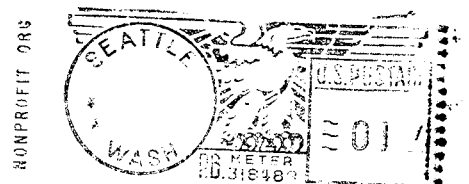
