KEITH 47.2, HALL 4:14.0, BUTTLE 9:14.6 ...

Despite another week of cold, wet weather last week, the marks started getting hot. Keith Tinner, Dan Watson's Lincoln sprinter we all by now know so well, ran the fastest 440 of his career -- 47.2 -- to highlight another excellent Shelton Invitational Saturday night.

Keith ran 9.9/21.7 in the heats at Shelton on a very wet afternoon, into the teeth of an icy gale. His 21.7 beat the field by a second and set the stage for the evening: it was only about 40 degrees but the wind and the rain stopped. The home team's Tony Molinero opened the night with a PR 14.6, and a meet of superlatives was on.

Tinner was the topper with 9.8/21.6/47.2/47.7r, the latter slow for him because of stomach cramps (because he had 3 hamburgers and 2 orders of fries just before the meet). The quarter is the fastest ever in the state by a prep (tho equal to the yards equivalent of the 46.9 Keith ran for meters last summer). It's second nationally so far this year. With warm weather still presumably ahead, it makes all of us think that Keith actually may press Ron Ray's national prep record of 45.8.

Rogers' Mike Hadway again beat Wilson's Harold Celms, this time in the stretch, 4:17.0 to 4:18.2. Then came Foss' Willy Smith, a shocker at 4:19.8 (7-second PR); Foss' first-year coach, Jim Black, was ecstatic. The distances at Shelton were full of surprises: Federal Way's Jim Brisendine 4:21, Kelso soph Mickey Ziegler 4:23, Fife's Steve Stageberg down from 9:53 to 9:30. A dozen milers were at 4:26 or better, 10 2-milers under 9:40, 22(!) halfmilers under 2:02, 16 quartermilers under 51.5.

Lincoln, walkaway winner at Shelton, had beaten rival Wilson on Thursday in a big dual, 83-53, with Steve Kiesel the hero: 4:20.1 PR for ~~and~~ to Celms in the mile and a great stretch drive to win the half in 1:57. At Shelton he stuck to the quarter and ran a shocking 49.3 out of the blocks to get second to Tinner.

The Kingco Relays were highlighted by Dan Buttle's 9:14.6, state-leading. Dan Lux was a surprise 2nd with 9:29; soph Kirk Spangler ran another 9:30. On Friday, Lynnwood's Scott Hall ran 4:14.0 to bury Sheldon Davis(4:21.0. In Spokane, Ferris' Doug Beckman switched to the two-mile with much success(PR 9:29). Two low-hurdlers hit 19.9(Andy Newing, John Arnold); Dean Pedigo raised his disc lead to 179-9; Everett's Doug Dalum, though overshadowed, ran a fine 48.9; Rick Gehrts won at Shelton with 1:55.2; Gregg Salvage jumped 6-7 and Joe Underwood, a soph at West Valley/Spokane, flopped 6-6 behind teammate Ed Mann's 6-7. Ron Clausen, despite cold, windy weather, vaulted 15-3½.

This week, the West Valley Invitational in Spokane is the state's biggest meet. The Highline Relays, which has only one individual event, is Friday night. The big race there will be the two-mile relay, where Lincoln and Wilson think they can push 7:50.

Suggs ran 9.3 in a triangular in tiny Roanoke Rapids, NC, to equal again the national prep record. Tinner's 47.2 stands 2nd to Collins and just ahead of the 47.3 by Bill Cork, Hamlin, Tex. Crenshaw, half leader, did NOT qualify for his state meet: he ran a nonqual 1:57.6 in his regional. Distance man Kimball(who is on his way to Oregon State U) doubled in 8:57.4/4:11.9.

Our vaulters, Clausen(15-3½) and Dudley(15-1¼), stand 11th and 12th nationally. Last week at the Kansas Relays, Tim Riley(East-Wichita) beat Tad Scales(Lawrence) on misses at 15-6.

In the Penn Relays, junior Rudy Rudyreavis (New Rochelle NY) beat Tim Walker(Providence RI) on misses at 6-10. Already this year 15 preps have jumped 6-10 or better. Leader Tully no-heighted at Mt. SAC last weekend. Ron Klotzer (Union NJ) won the Penn shot with 63-7. Javelin leader Perbeck won Kansas with 222-2. Two-mile winners were Mike Hagon(Suffern NY), 9:02.2 at Penn, and junior Ralph Serna(Loera Cal), 9:03.8 at Mt. SAC. Lee's Summit Va. took the 4-mile-relay lead with 17:30.6. /from Jack Shepard/

COUGARS VS. HUSKIES

Following rather dismal performances on equally dismal days, Washington State and Washington head into the face-to-face test of the year in the state. The Huskies and Cougars collide in Pullman for the 56th time this Saturday, in what promises to be one of the best ever meets in the series. The Cougs must get a slight nob because of home turf and stronger sprinters. The Dogs must rely on field event strength. Last week the Cougars extended their dual record to 6-1 with easy wins over Montana and Weber State, while San Jose State was handing Coach Shannon and his purple and gold boys their first dual loss of the season. They had been rated 5th in the nation prior to the meet.

Marks were not outstanding during the meets. Mother Nature once again ruled the day with cool temperatures, wind, rain and generally miserable conditions. Russ Vincent came within 3/4" of his PR with 59-9. Fred Luke won the Mt. SAC Relays javelin with 257-0, and Mark Smith/PLU used a strong Ellensburg wind to add nearly ten feet to his discus PR with a sterling 186-6, the best throw ever by a small college athlete in the state. Ralph Mann and Pablo Franco ran great 440's considering conditions, 48.4 and 47.9 respectively. Tim Geisa had a remarkable double 9.6w/21.6w in the Cougar-Weber State meet.

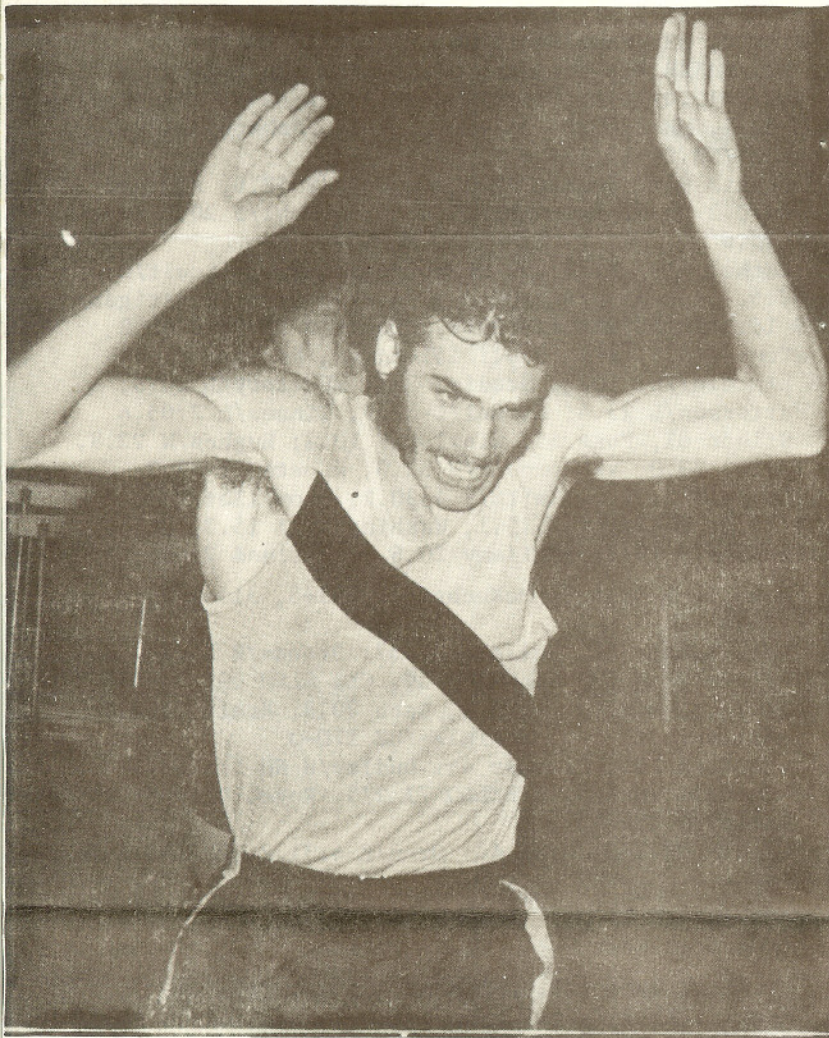
