WEATHER, AND ATHLETES, WARM UP

Last Saturday blossomed forth with the year's first 60-degree weather on the west side, and 70-degree on the east side, and that conveniently coincided with the Shoreline and Pasco invitationals that day.

Wilson scored heavily on the track to edge Lincoln at Pasco, 92-82, while Bellevue was a surprise winner at Shoreline. Wilson's top performances came from juniors Harold Celms, who outkicked Doug Beckman of Ferris to win the mile, 4:17.2, and Lorenzo Bellamy, who ran a season-leading 20.0 in the lows.

The Pasco meet had some hot field marks, from Dennis Dudley, who vaulted a PR 15-1½, and Dave McDuffie, who improved his triple-jump PR two feet with 46-6 to best Jon Harris, Grandview, 45-5½. The javelin was sensational as Gene Lorenzen, East Valley, fresh from 214-6 during the week, was upset by Kamiakin's Rich Stewart, 213-10 to 210-5. Kent Mackay, Connell, was third with his first 200-footer, 204-9. Lincoln's Keith Tinner ran 22.0/49.4 for two wins, then overhauled Borah in the mile relay with a 47.9 anchor.

At Shoreline, Dan Buttle, Bothell, ran a solo 4:17.1 to take the state mile lead, and Edmonds' Craig Martin accomplished the same in the 2 with 9:26.0. A dozen runners broke 10 minutes.

The track was torn up by a very long day of running on its cinder surface by hundreds of boys, & girls. Times in the evening were not special. Garland Watkins outclassed the sprinters, and ran 9.9/22.7 in reasonable conditions in the heats.

Ed Mann, junior at Spokane's West Valley, jumped 6-7 3/4 during the week to take the state lead there.

This week, many eastside schools will be at Gonzaga Saturday and many westside ones at South Kitsap.

HUSKIES, COUGARS GO TO THE WILLAMETTE VALLEY

Undefeated Washington and Washington State both travel into the heartland of track in America this weekend with tough duals at Oregon State and Oregon respectively. The Huskies and Cougars are both coming off close wins, the Huskies besting Cal for the first time since 1932 with a come from behind win in the mile relay, and the Cougs topping Oregon State 87-76 in Pullman. Pablo Franco led the Dogs with a 47.4 anchor in the relay and nipping Cal's Rick Brown at the tape. Pablo also ran 48.0 in the open, Russ Vincent getting a PR 58-1½ in the shot, and frosh Robin Earl besting previously undefeated Borys Chambul 174-5 to 174-3. Kip Ngeno led the Cougars with two meet records, 14.0/52.2. John Ngeno remained undefeated 13:28.6, and Dale Scott edged Hailu Ebba in the 880 1:49.1 to 1:49.4.

Elsewhere, it finally became known the SCC's Kurt Beckman did indeed set a national JC mark in the 6M at the Shoreline mini-meet in February. His 28:51.0 bettered the old mark of Mark Covert by 4 seconds. Mark Stream, SPC junior, had himself quite a day, celebrating the first sunshine of the season with 14.8 PR/53.5 PR, SR/6-4(2). Mike Vorce of Western ran the open 440 instead of the hurdles or the time may have been even faster.

Dana LeDuc of Texas has been hot lately, winning the Texas Relays SP with a PR 64-8 3/4. A week earlier he had a PR 188-7 in the discus. Both are the best ever by a Washingtonian.

Last week's most productive meet was the San Jose Invitational, where Mike Farmer (Wilson-San Francisco) established his sprint superiority with 9.5 to defeat Millard Hampton (9.5) and Elijah Jefferson (Crawford-San Diego), 9.6. Hampton came back for a nation-leading 20.9 220 ahead of sophomore Glen Cannon (Mt. Pleasant-San Jose), 21.5, and Jefferson, 21.6.

But the really wowing sprint news was in Florida where senior Stanley Harris and junior James Brown, teammates at Mainland-Daytona Beach, ran windy 9.3/9.4 and, on a straight, 20.0 and 20.2!

Another vaulter over 16: Tad Scales, Lawrence, Kan., 16-2; and Tim Johnson up to 15-10½. Another Kansan, Tim Riley, East-Wichita, now at 15-7.

Beedle, the new 7-footer, beat the other one, Ridge, at 6-10¼ on misses last week, then went 7 2 days later. And in Indiana, 6-11½ by Noel Ruebel of Highland. The 14-year-old world record was broken by John Kranz, frosh at Westchester-Houston, Tex., with 6-5.

In a big 2-mile relay in Virginia, Menchville of Newport News came from behind on strength of 1:51.5 anchor by Frankie Watts, who passed Mike Ellington, junior who anchored Ferguson-Newport News in 1:53.0. Menchville won, 7:48.8 to 7:49.0.

Discus man Burton last week threw 197-6, 184-3 and 195-10. Gillette, co-leader in the hurdles, also has thrown the disc 158. New Jersey, which does not throw the hammer, has produced a hammer thrower anyway: Greg Mancino, North Bergen-Bergen, 191-5 with the high-school weight.

We sadly report two deaths: a month ago Frank McMurrey, a Texas boy who had vaulted 15-6 indoors, died after collapsing at the finish of an 880 relay (Frank visited Seattle last summer and was considering going to school in the Northwest), and last week Kyle Doudican, 6-8½ jumper as a freshman in Pauls Valley, Okla., died of leukemia.
