

Ute Thinclads Down Aggies

The University of Utah, receiving a clutch performance from its mile relay team, crept to a tight victory over Utah State, 78-76) in a dual track meet at Robert L. Rice Stadium Monday afternoon.

Going into the final event of the day, which fortunately for the Utes was the mile relay, the Aggies held a 76-73 lead.

But Utes Kevin Simmons, Kim Taylor, Doug McKenzie and Brent Webster combined their talents well in the mile relay and swept to a victory with a 3:14.7 clocking. The triumph was worth five points and provided the margin of victory.

The long-awaited battle between Utah State's Mark Enyeart and Utah's Brent Webster took place Monday and the two put on quite a show.

In the feature event of the day, ~~Enyeart sped to a victory in the 440 with a time of .46.7. Webster was close behind at .46.9.~~

But Webster earned his revenge in the 220, finishing first to Enyeart's second and set-

ting a new school record in the process. Webster's time of :20.7 broke the old record of :21.1 set by Dean Morgan in 1966.

Other Ute winners on a clear but cool day were Tom Takach in the steeplechase, Rick Lord in the mile run, Dan Ball in the high hurdles; Keith Gines in the 100, Jon Liddiard in the javelin and Greg Hay in the triple jump. Utes Bill Memales, Randy George, Gines and Webster provided a victory in the 440 relay.
