WSU freshman goes 7-1 $\frac{1}{4}$

PULLMAN, Wash. (AP) — Freshman high jumper Lee Braach set a school record by clearing 7 feet, 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ inches in leading Washington State to victories over Idaho and Boise State in a double dual track meet Saturday.

The Cougars defeated Boise State 124-58 and Idaho 131-40, while Boise State downed Idaho 87-70.

Braach, from Seattle, easily cleared 7-1 $\frac{1}{4}$, then missed three times at 7-2 $\frac{3}{8}$. The old school record was 7-1, set in 1970 by Peter Wright.

The Cougars won 14 of 19 events and Boise State captured the remaining five.

SWU's Kip Ngeno and Gary Minor were the meet's

only double winners. Ngeno took the high hurdles in a wind-aided 14-flat and won the intermediate hurdles in 53.6. Minor took a 9.6-second wind-aided victory in the 100 and covered the 220 in 21.3 seconds, again wind-aided.
