Dallas meet

It goes to mile relay and Bears win, 76-69

DALLAS — Officials cancelled the Dallas Invitational Track and Field meet yesterday because of cold weather and water on the field.

At the time of the cancellation about 1 p.m., the temperature was 38 degrees and a stiff north wind was blowing. Hail and rain had fallen during the morning, and forecasts were for worsening conditions.

USC was favored over a field which included University of Texas-El Paso, Southwest Conference champion Texas, Kansas State, Oklahoma State, Baylor, Texas A&M and Southern Methodist.

These California-Oregon State dual meets always seem to go right down to 3:30 p.m. or so, to the mile relay, but yesterday's meet was even a little hairier than the norm before the Bears won out, 76-69.

This is how close it was: with one lap remaining on the mile relay OSU Coach Berny Wagner had Ghanan Yaw Atuahene standing by to run his fourth race — second in 10 minutes — if Cal had not developed an unbeatable lead.

But when Cal's third man, Mike Grasha handed the baton to James Robinson with

an eight yard lead, Atuahene knew he wasn't needed. Robinson had already run the fastest 880 of the U.S. outdoor season, 1:49.3, and there may not be a man living who can make up an eight yard deficit on him.

Certainly not Jake Groth. The race was completed in 3:16.4, Robinson cruising to a very easy 49.0 lap with Groth bringing the Beavers in at 3:20.0.

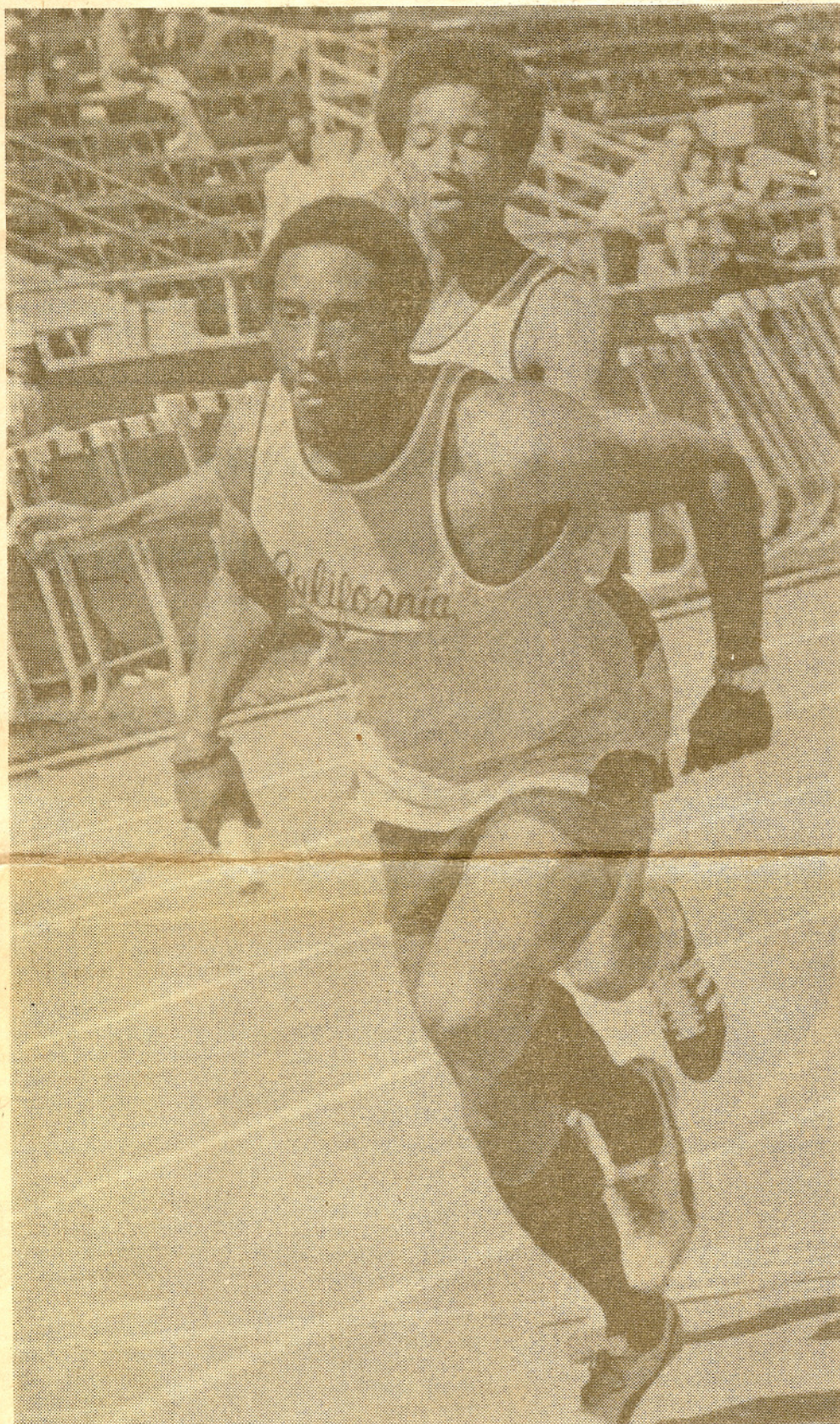
In truth, though it was not the mile relay which did in the Beavers but the 440 relay. Entering the last leg OSU had a clear lead and Frank Jackson, who had made something of a miracle recovery following an

ankle injury Tuesday, ready to run the anchor leg against Tony Campbell.

But Jackson dropped the baton pass from teammate Jim Henry.

Since Jackson later finished second in the 100 at 9.8 while Campbell was sixth at 10.0 it is not unfair to assume OSU would have won the race. And, if they had, they would have won the meet, 74-71.

It was a splendid Donnybrook of a meet all the way through with both teams coming up with lifetime bests, more than a few surprises and some courageous doubles too.



Atuahene ran the sprint relay, won the 440 in 47.8, finished second in the 220 at 21.8 and was anxious for the chance to race Robinson at the end. Fellow African student, Lucas Oloo, from Kampala, Uganda, eased to a 4:06.6 mile victory and then, after soaking his legs in ice water, came back to run second to teammate Randy Brown in the three mile at 13:49.6.
