Before a crowd of some 2,000 people, the Second Annual Etobicoke Guardian Track Invitational saw several top performances by local talent - the basic purpose of the competition.

Glenn Bogue, the Canadian junior 400 metre record holder at 46.8 seconds, returned home from his freshman year at Villanova and won a hard-fought race against veteran Clyde McPherson and Dennis Dyce, both from the New York Pioneer Club. Coming off the last bend, it was a six man race, with Bogue and McPherson driving hard into the turn. Bogue maintained his stride and kept a stride lead all the way down the stretch-run, to the delight of the hometown fans.

In the invitational men's 1500 metres, Mike Housley (Notre Dame) took a good field through the first 400 metres in 58.9 seconds and continued his lead through 600 metres when Chicago's Bruce Fischer took over, followed closely by John Sharp and Peter Richardson. At the half, in 1:59, Ed Takacs, fresh off his win in the IC4A's 880, pushed the pace up with his 57 second 400, leading at 1200 metres and carrying through with a good early season time, and a personal best of 3:43.8. In fact the next two Canadians came up with Pb's - Joe Sax, the 3000 metre steeplechase record holder, with a 3:44.9 and John Sharp at 3:45.9 (ranking him fourth with Chicago's Lowell Paul just edging Sharp out at the wire).

The competition turned in three new Canadian records. In the pole vault, 15 year old Mark Bradley went over 4.40 metres (14'5 1/4") on his third attempt, for a new Canadian midget record. Detroit's

Motor City squad ran a 1:39.6 4 x 200 metre relay, for a new Canadian open women's record. Track West, in the men's 4 x 800 relay, broke an old Canadian record, set way back in August of 1960 with renowned Bill Crothers and Bruce Kidd on that team, with a clocking of 7:34.0 to best the record by 2.6 seconds. In the relay, Track West's Tom Potter came off the final bend smoothly and put his team into a comfortable lead with a 1:52.8 clocking. Gary Crossley, suffering from a month-old hamstring problem, went through in 1:56.6, and thus Steve Lincoln had to play catch-up to put the team back into first with a 1:53.4 time. At this point, both Track West's Tom Lobsinger (17 years old) and the Quebec Provincial Team's Gene Mercer were running neck and neck, with Scarborough Optimists lingering some 10 seconds back. Optimists' Eric Chapman - now graduated from the University of Michigan, ran a strong 1:47.8 anchor leg to bring his team up to third place, but Quebec held on to seconds and Track West, with a sparkling 1:51.2 from Tom Lobsinger, won going away, and a new record to boot.

All in all, a most exciting 2½ hours of good competition.
