

# Vikes Set Records In GCC Relays

2/23/75

SAN MATEO—West Valley College set meet marks in the 4-mile relay and pole vault and also claimed victories in the distance medley and high jump relays Saturday at the 13th annual Golden Gate Conference Track & Field Relays at College of San Mateo.

Craig Sullivan anchored the Vikes 4-mile relay team with a 4:19.2 mile as the team clocked 17:25.4 to finish 12 seconds ahead of De Anza. Scott Turner vaulted 14-6 $\frac{1}{4}$  as he teamed with Leo Linn and Ralph Baker for a meet mark of 42-0 $\frac{3}{4}$ . Ryan Paton of San Mateo also claimed an individual vault mark with his 15-5 which bettered the 15-4 by Dennis Phillips, also of CSM, in 1966. Phillips served as Paton's coach last year at Oregon State.

# Two meet records set in GCC relays

Two meet records were broken and another tied yesterday as the new JC track season opened with the Golden Gate Conference Relays at College of San Mateo.

Millard Hampton blazed to a 20.7 clocking on his leg of the 880 relay to lead San Jose CC to a 1:26.5 clocking, which tied a meet record.

West Valley established the two records, running the four mile relay in 17:25.4, and totalling 42-0 $\frac{3}{4}$  in the pole vault.

City College's Mike Farmer, who ran in the same races as former high school rival Hampton but not on the same legs, turned in a 48.4 second leg performance in the mile relay, and outran San Jose's Don Livers in the 880 relay.
