

# TWO U.S. JC MARKS FALL AT LONG BEACH

Two national junior college records and a fast shuttle, high hurdle relay time by USC featured the Long Beach Relays Saturday at Long Beach State.

Dave Babiracki of the San Fernando Track Club won the three mile in 13:27.6, but freshman Bob Thomas of Glendale College finished second in 13:36.4 to set a national junior college record breaking the old mark of Grossmont's Ed Mendoza (13:39.1 in 1973).

Grossmont set a national JC record of 16:59.2 in the four-mile relay, finishing second to Long Beach State. Allegany College of Pennsylvania set the old record of 17:00.2 in 1974.

USC's shuttle high hurdle relay team ran 56.1, two-tenths of a second off of Florida's collegiate record.
