## Mc Phatter places in four events

# Women finish second in track meet

The women's track team shared the spotlight last Saturday with UCLA as both teams dominated the Aztec's first and last home track meet of the season.

UCLA finished first in the eight team meet with 181 points. SDSU was second with 119 points, 68 points ahead of third place University of Southern California.

The Bruins won eight of the 15 events. SDSU won two events and placed in every event but the 440 yard dash.

Pat McPhatter took a first in the long jump with a jump of 16'9". Teammate Susie Niehues placed third with a 16'4" jump.

Miss McPhatter also placed third in the 220 yard dash, fourth in the 880 yard medley relay and third in the 440 yard relay.

Terri Wiley won the javelin throw with a toss of 141'3" and Pam Lindsay added a third place for the Aztecs.

Miss Wiley also led her teammates in the shot put with a throw of 34', good for second place. Marianne Perrault and Bev Dixon

finished third and fourth with throws of 33'7" and 31'9".

In the high jump, Betsy Connor finished second with a 5' jump, and Marianne Blethen jumped 4'4" for fifth place.

Donnetta Moore threw the discus 105'6" for a third in that event, and teammate Barb Loneragan's fourth-place throw was 105'½".

Miss Niehues and Noreen Cicchetto placed third and fourth, respectively, in the 400 meter low hurdles. Miss Niehues also finished fourth in the 100 yard intermediate hurdles, along with Connor who finished sixth.

Kelly Young ran a 12.1 in the 100 yard dash, good for fourth place.

The two-mile run was actually the two-and-a-quarter-mile run because of a mix-up by the lap

counter, and Michelle Croker and Dalana Pursel placed fifth and sixth for the Aztecs. In the mile run, Robin Ensor placed sixth.

The 880 yard medley relay team, run by Misses Cicchetto, Niehues, McPhatter and Evayon Farnum, qualified for the nationals with a time of 1:51.1. The national time standard for qualifying is 1:53.0. The time was good for a fourth place in Saturday's meet.

Misses Blethen, Crocker, Jean Schlemmer and P. A. Fort paced the Aztecs to a third place in the one-mile relay. Misses Cicchetto, Farnum, McPhatter and Haweda Nash ran a 49.8 in the 440 yard relay and finished third.

The women will leave Friday for California State University, Long Beach, their next league meet.
