

Cal's Robinson faster

Last week California's James Robinson proved he is stronger than he was a year ago by winning a mile race and yesterday he demonstrated he is also faster as he ran 47.4 in the quarter-mile to help the Bears to a 96-49 dual meet victory over San Diego State at Laney JC's all-weather track.

It was supposed to have been a three-way meet with Fullerton State but the Titans could not afford the travel expenses and had to cancel.

Robinson led all the way in the 440 and since his nearest competitor was $2\frac{1}{2}$ seconds back, he did not really press himself to the limit. It is hard to keep from wondering what he will run when he gets into his specialty — the half-mile.
