

San Jose St.

overruns

two foes

SAN DIEGO — With Ron Livers and Mike Weeks leading the way, San Jose State swept every field event yesterday on its way to dual meet victories over San Diego State and Nevada-Las Vegas.

The Spartans outscored Pacific Coast Athletic Association rival San Diego, 91-52, and routed Las Vegas 112-21.

Livers won both his specialties, clearing 6-10 in the high jump and getting off a triple jump of 51-2 $\frac{3}{4}$. Weeks was also a double winner, putting the shot 55-7 and throwing the discus 163-2.

Concerned over Ronald Whitaker's sore leg, SJS Coach Ernie Bullard held him out of every event except the sprint relay in which Whitaker anchored the team to victory in 41.6 without opposition. The Aztecs dropped the baton on the first handoff.
