



Damp, but easy 880 win for SJS' Mark Schilling 3/9/75

Spartan Trackmen Clear Stanford Hurdle Handily

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previous best of 52.9, recorded last year.

The fans just had enough time to catch their breath as SJS' Bruce Smiley claimed the 220 in 21.6 when "Doubell" Krause lined up for the two-mile.

Running second to Stanford's Mark McConnell for six laps, Krause exploded in the final 880 to win in 8:51.8 — another lifetime best.

"I knew I had it after three laps," said the extremely pleased junior from Lynbrook High School. "The time surprised me, though. I thought I could do 8:56.

"I'll tell you, Riggs makes us tough. I won't make any predictions on how fast I will go, but if I ever become good, I'll tell you what 'Doubell' means."

If Krause keeps improving at his present rate, he might just be favorably compared to Australian distance star Ralph Doubell sooner than he expects. So much for the secret.

Inclement weather held down the performances in the field events, although Ron Livers set a meet record in the triple jump of 51-61-4. The old mark was 50-6½ set by SJS' Adrian Porter in 1969.

Ron and Charles Mackey also shared a first in the high jump at 6-8.

Another tie occurred in the pole vault as the Spartans' Roger Martin and Larry Johnson cleared 15-0.

SJS weightman Mike Weeks doubled, winning the shot put at 54-4½ and discus at 161-3.
