A LITTLE INVITATIONAL HISTORY

Born from an idea nine years ago in 1967, the San Jose Invitational has grown up into one of the nation's top track & field meets, and this year takes on a new name which it will retain through next season's contest - the San Jose National Bicentennial Invitational Track & Field Meet. Way back in 1967, Tommie Smith, then competing for San Jose State College, gave an indication of things to come in the future as the slim speedster established a new quarter-mile World Record, blazing the one-lap distance in 44.8. The record still stands today as an Invitational record, although his world record has been bypassed several times since then. But many of the standards still standing through this 9th running of the Invitational include a world outdoor shotput mark (71-7) by Al Feuerbach in 1973; the first sub-four mile clocking in Santa Clara County by the Oregon Track Club's Arne Kvalheim in 1971 (3:58.1); a then-American record in the women's shotput by Maren Seidler in 1974; plus numerous world-class marks including Jim Bolding's 49.6 IH clocking in '74, a 218-7 discus toss by John Powell in 1973, a 20.3 220 performance by John Carlos in 1970, a 7-2% high jump by Reynaldo Brown (1974), and on and on. Last year, graced by good weather and a receptive crowd, 20 meet records were shattered and 5 field records established, and 1975 may promise the same.

Last year's meet saw the expansion of the high school, age group, and women's programs and now qualifying meets leading to the Invitational have been expanded so that the '75 Invitational offers 53 events, including 20 women's/girl's events, a pentathlon contest, and 6 high school battles intermingled with similar top-notch competition in the open events. The 1975 SJNBI Track & Field Meet is sponsored by the San Jose Mercury-News, San Jose State University Track & Field, and the City of San Jose's Bicentennial Commission which has designated this meet as one of the major city Bicentennial projects for 1976.

So sit back and enjoy what may be one of the feature Track & Field Meets of 1975. Your announcers today will be Bob Smith of Arizona, Bill Gilbert, the San Jose State Track & Field announcer for the dual meet season, and John Fuller, an assistant of Gilbert's and the official statistician of the meet. The 1975 Games Committee appreciates your involvement in San Jose athletics.
