## Bay does well

SANTA BARBARA — Santa Barbara City College was the only triple winner yesterday at the 37th annual Santa Barbara Invitational track meet, also known as the Easter Relays. The school won the shuttle hurdle, 440 and 880 relays.

However, Bay Area teams were winners in eight events. John LeGrande of West Valley broke the only meet record with a 50  $9\frac{3}{4}$  leap in the triple jump. He also was third in the long jump and was voted outstanding athlete of the meet's jaycee section.
