1975 HUSKY TRACK AND FIELD OUTLOOK

SPRINTS---Expected to be Washington's strongest area this year. Returning veterans include defending PAC-8 champion Al Davis (9.5), junior from Bellevue who won the conference race in 9.7; Pablo Franco, sophomore from Hartford, Connecticut, who did not run last year due to an injury, but comes back as a threat in the 100 and 220. Pablo was the nation's fastest prep sprinter in 1973 (9.4, 20.9) while competing for Hartford Public School. Franco zipped to a 30.9 indoor 300 this year to set an Edmundson Pavilion record. Billy Hicks, senior from Spokane Falls CC and a member of Washington's school record-setting quartermile relay team (39.9) of last year, adds yet another dimension to the Husky sprint corps. Hicks, who owns bests of 21.0 and 46.7, set a pair of Pavilion indoor records this year (48.6 quarter and 1:10.7 600) and ran with Franco, Brian Mondschein and Keith Tinner on the indoor mile relay team which went 3:18.4 for another Pavilion mark. Bellevue junior Dan Elkins (9.8, 21.2) also returns. New-comers include San Francisco frosh Mike Kirtman, a 13.8 prep hurdler who also owns a 9.5 and a 6.2 indoor 60; Loren Williams, freshman from Winnipeg, Canada, with bests of 10.4m and 21.8m and Greg Thornsburg, sophomore from Compton with a 9.6 and 21.8 to his credit.

QUARTER---Strength carries into this area, also, with the return of Hicks (47.2) and Franco (47.9) coupled with the addition of freshman ace Keith Tinner from Lincoln High School of Tacoma. Tinner (21.6, 47.2) is a three-time State of Washington quarter champ and collected two state golds in the furlong. Depth will be provided by Dave Garrison, senior from Oak Harbor (48.6); Jerry Belur, Renton junior (47.5r); Tim Byrne, junior from Edmond, Oklahoma (47.2r) and Brian Mondschein, sophomore from Havertown, Pennsylvania who is returning after an injury forced him to redshirt last year.

MIDDLE DISTANCES (800, Mile)---The Huskies will be weakened by the possible loss of Greg Gibson, junior from Connell, who has posted a 1:48.6 halfmile and a 3:59.1 indoor mile (4:04.5 outdoors). Greg has been nursing a strained back during the 1975 indoor season and he is questionable for the outdoor campaign. The 880 load will be carried by Dan Winger (1:50.8), Seattle senior; Steve Cotsirilos (1:52.4), senior from River Forrest,

Illinois; Al Herbert (1:52.4), senior from Los Angeles and Tim Byrne (1:54.2). Also available will be freshman newcomer Mark Piccillo from San Leandro, California, who has a best of 1:55.8. Top milers include senior Scott Holmes (4:08.8); Bob Goiney, Seattle senior (4:09.1) and Winger (4:10.3).

DISTANCES (2-Mile, 3-Mile, 6-Mile, SC)---Scott Holmes, the versatile senior, should be the mainstay for the Huskies in the distances along with sophomore Gordy Braun from Seattle's Shoreline. Holmes owns clockings of 8:51.4, 13:43.6 and an 8:53.0 steeple to set the Husky distance pace. Braun owns a 13:42 3-mile and a 28:58 6-mile, the third fastest six in school history. Gordy also has registered a 4:08.3 mile. Help will come from returning veterans Mike Tolleson, junior from Sacramento (13:52.2, 29:25.6); Bellevue junior Bill Glad (13:55.4, 29.09.0); junior college transfer Graham Barr (Mt. Hood CC) with a 13:53.4 and freshman Steve Surface from Eugene, Oregon, the state cross country champion and second place winner in the 2-mile (8:58.7). Steve also has a 13:52.9 3-mile.

HURDLES---Brian Mondschein, who as a freshman took third in the PAC-8 with a 51.9 intermediate hurdles clocking, returns to action after sitting out last year with an ankle injury. "Moon" holds the UW decathlon record with 6872 points, although he has a personal best of 6911 which he recorded last summer in Pennsylvania. Jerry Belur (52.2) should also offer help. It is a question how the Huskies will fare in the highs, but the field should be strengthened by freshman Mike Kirtman who already has clocked 7.2 indoors to equal the UW indoor record and qualify for an NCAA berth. Nelse Petermann (14.6) and Tony Dean (15.2) will offer depth.

SHOT PUT---Sophomore Russ Vincent from Seattle's Ballard High is the Huskies' premier putter with an outdoor best of 59-11 and a 60-8 3/4 mark achieved during the 1975 indoor campaign. Russ was a member of the United States junior team which competed against the Russians last year and Vincent took a second. Backup help should come from George Sutherland (55-10), junior from Port Townsend, who went 56-10 1/2 indoors this season to vastly improve on his best mark. Borys Chambul, who did not compete outdoors last year, has registered a 54-0 1/2 indoor mark this season and should offer depth in the shot put ring.

DISCUS---Junior Borys Chambul from Scarborough, Canada, who set a school record with a 189-9 throw as a sophomore, leads the Husky discus field into action. Borys was a member of the National Canadian Senior Team last summer. He took sixth in the NCAA's with a 182-6 effort. Joining Chambul will be sophomore Robin Earl from Kent who has a best of 178-10. Robin was a teammate with Vincent on the USA team which met the Russians. Earl was a prep All-American and state record holder at 192-7 (1973). He is the Huskies' number one fullback in the fall, but is allowed to devote his springtime athletic attention to track and field.

POLE VAULT---It was three years ago when Jeff Taylor cleared 17-0 indoors, but inconsistency has plagued him since, until this past indoor season when he went 17-6 to set the stage for optimistic outdoor campaign. The Bellevue senior took a second in last year's NCAA meet (17-3) and is the man to watch in 1975. Backing Taylor will be Ron Clausen, freshman from Seattle's Shorecrest High, who was the state champion at 15-6 last year.

JAVELIN---NCAA runner-up Rod Ewaliko (254-1), junior from Hawaii, will again pace the Husky javelin field this year. "Chai" Ahrenius will offer back-up help. Ahrenius is a transfer from Shoreline CC who went 215-2 as a Husky last year.

HIGH JUMP---John Hayes, sophomore from Seattle's Blanchet High who was injury-plagued last year, will carry the Husky colors into the high jump pit where he owns a best of 6-11 as a high school senior. He has gone 6-10 during the 1975 indoor season and promises to be a top contender throughout the outdoor campaign. Mike Radford, freshman from Seattle's Nathan Hale High has cleared 6-7 and should provide good depth. Radford already owns the UW indoor pentathlon record with 3634 points.

TRIPLE JUMP---Returning veteran Wayne Hinkley (50-9) leads the field and the reliable junior from Yakima provides a durable base for the Huskies in this event. Wayne will hope to get help from Gerry Baugh (47-6), senior from Vancouver, Washington and Tony Dean (45-8) sophomore from Seattle's O'Dea. Both have shown promise during winter workouts.

LONG JUMP---Hinkley will be doing double duty in hopes of improving his 23-11 best in this event and will be joined by footballer Ken Conley, senior from Walla Walla CC, who has gone 24-2, but has not long jumped in two years.

WASHINGTON'S COACHES

HEAD COACH KEN SHANNON

Ken is in his seventh year as Washington's track and field coach, and the personable Husky spike pilot returns to the helm as optimistic as ever.

After guiding the Huskies to a 4-2 dual meet record last year and a ninth place tie (with Western Kentucky) in the national championships, Shannon welcomes back the nucleus of his 1974 squad.

Since joining the Washington athletic department in the fall of 1968, Shannon has systematically and energetically lifted the track and field program into standards of the highest competitive quality.

A former shot and discus standout at Occidental College, Ken has become one of the nation's foremost experts in field event coaching where his individuals have always been strong challengers in NCAA competition.

Among his many achievements, Ken was recently named as an assistant coach for the development of javelin throwers for the 1976 Olympic Games. Four of his Husky athletes competed in the 1972 Olympiad and he has turned out nine PAC-8 conference champions and one NCAA champ.

Shannon attended Porterville High School in California, spent one year at Porterville Junior College and then went on to Occidental where he distinguished himself as a track and football standout.

He served as Oxy's head track coach from 1961-1964 and then joined the UCLA staff as an assistant until called to Washington four years later.

Ken, his wife Janet and their three youngsters reside in Woodinville, a Seattle suburb.

WASHINGTON'S COACHES

ASSISTANT COACH DIXON FARMER

Dixon joined his long-time friend Ken Shannon as assistant coach last fall, coming to Washington from the University of Michigan where he had spent three years as head track and field coach.

In addition to assisting Shannon with all the runners, Dixon also serves as the Husky cross country coach.

After a distinguished competitive career at Occidental College where he was an NCAA intermediate hurdles champion in 1961, Farmer joined the Oxy staff as assistant coach upon his graduation in 1963. He was elevated to the head post in 1968, and after four successful years, Farmer took over the helm at Michigan in 1972.

During each of his four years as head coach at Occidental, Farmer produced a conference championship in both track and cross country, and at Michigan, he took a cross country program that had been idle for 20 years and turned it into a Big Ten contender with two third places and a second place finish in his three years at Ann Arbor.

In addition to his 1961 NCAA intermediate hurdles gold medal, Farmer distinguished himself while representing the United States in dual meets against Russia, Poland, Germany and England. He was the AAU pentathlon champion in 1959, and the following year he took sixth place in the AAU decathlon. Farmer earned nine conference titles as an Occidental undergraduate.

Dixon, his wife Mary Ann and their two children reside in Woodinville. He is a native of Orinda, California.
