Harbor First, Aptos Second In Big Meet

KING CITY — Harbor High's girls' track team edged Aptos by one team point for first place in Saturday's King City Invitational Girls' Track and Field Meet.

The Pirate gals, led by high-point trophy winner Lezli Peterson, scored 34 points, followed by Aptos with 33.

Miss Peterson won the top individual trophy on the strength of two first places finishes. Her 60.3 clocking in the 440-yard dash established a new school and meet record. She also won the 100-yard dash in 11.9, and was a member of Harbor's third place 440-yard relay team and first place 880-yard medley relay team.

The medley team, comprised of Miss Peterson, Chris Chiechi, Julie Peterson and Carrie Cavanah, ran the fcourse in 1:56.6. The same girls were clocked at 52.0 for

third in the 440-vard race.

Cathy Hargens established a new meet and school record with a first place finish in the discus with a 98-9% distance. Also taking a Harbor first was Marie Garcia, who won the shot put with a toss of 40 feet, good for a meet record.

Other Harbor places came from Miss Cavanah, who was third in the 80-yard hurdles in 11.7, a team record, and Julie Peterson, who was third in the 440-yard dahs with a 62.0 clocking.

Aptos' girls registered three individual first place finishes.

In the half-mile run, Amy Huyck won with a 2:21.4 time and was second t Sue Neary in the mile. Miss Neary was time at 5:25.5 and was second to Miss Huyck in the half-mile.

Loretta Stewart won the 80-yard hurdles in 11.5

Karen Kirsch gained Aptos points with a third place 100yard dash finish (12.0), and Nancy Hart was fourth in the 220 at 27.8.

Aptos' medley relay team of Miss Huyck, Miss Hart, Miss Stewart and Miss Kirsch was third in 1:59.8, and the same girls combined for a fourth place finish in the 440-yard relay team in 52.8.
