

Bumper crop of frosh spikers shine

One of the best freshman track crops in recent years put on quite a show last night in the Sequoia District track and field championships.

Curt Foianini won three events and Bob Love won two to lead Carlmont to the team title with 102 points to San Carlos' 81, Sequoia's 58 and Woodside's 38.

Foianini won the 880 in 2:08.7, the 440 in 54.4 in a good race with San Carlos' Dave Gillooley and the discus by a long shot in 122-6½.

Love set a meet record by an amazing 20 seconds with a 9:54.2 in the two-mile and doubled in the mile in 4:46.6.

San Carlos' Stan Beal won both the sprints, tying the meet record with a 10.5 100-yard dash and setting a meet record with a 23.3 in the 220.

Also for the Dons, Rick Luttrell set a meet record 11-7 in the pole vault (which would have placed fourth in the varsity), won the 330 low hurdles in 40.4 and was a close second to Sequoia's Fred Oravillo in the 70 high hurdles.
