Trojans Breeze in Relays

USC's sprint relay teams ran swift races Saturday as coach Vern Wolfe's Trojans dominated the 40th annual Long Beach Relays.

Kevin Williams, Mike Simmons, James Sanford and Billy Mullins ran 39.2 seconds in the 400-meter relay, equaling the sixth fastest time on USC's all-time list.

The Trojan team of Rodney Betheney, Jim Walters, Henry Perez and David Omwansa ran the 800-meter relay in 1.23.4, third-best ever for USC.

Chares White, the Trojan All-American tailback, returned to track competition after an absence of almost four years, and finished third in the first 400-meter race with a time of 48.7 seconds. He once held the national interscholastic record in the 330-yard intermediate hurdles at San Fernando High School.

Randy Benson of the Maccabi Track Club, formerly of the University of Kansas, ran a 47.2-seconds 440.
