## COACHING STAFF

### Head Coach Dick Hill

In his sixth year as head track and field coach for San Diego State University, Dick Hill has brought to the Aztecs his background of professional success which includes coaching athletes to 30 world records, three individual gold medals, and many American, NCAA and NAIA records.

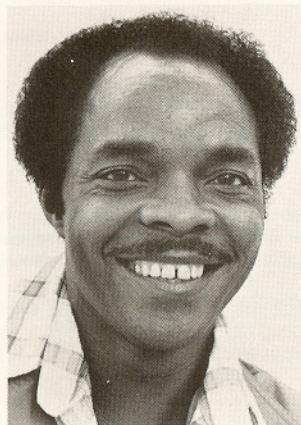
Hill came to San Diego State in 1973 from Southern University, where he coached from 1965 to 1969 and in 1971 and 1972. A 1960 alumnus of Southern with a B.S. in physical education, his teams there won five NAIA national titles in three years, and Hill was named National Track Coach of the Year. At one point his teams owned or tied every outdoor world record in the mile relay, had sole possession of the 440 relay, and were national champs and record holders in the 880 and sprint-medley relays. His Southern team was deemed "the most outstanding team of the decade" (1960-70) by *Track & Field News*.

Southern won NAIA championships outdoors in 1966, 1967, and 1968, as well as the 1966 and 1967 indoor titles. After a year's leave of absence in 1970 to complete his Ed.D (doctoral) degree at the State University of New York (Buffalo), Hill returned to Southern and in 1972, a five-man team placed fifth at the NAIA Nationals.

Hill began his collegiate coaching career at Florida A&M University, where he was head track coach and head basketball coach from 1962 to 1964.

Hill has had great success coaching individual athletes. At Florida A&M, he coached Bob Hayes to world records at 100-yards and 100-meters, as well as the 1964 Olympic gold medal. At Southern, Hill coached high hurdlers Willie Davenport, the 1968 Olympic champion, and Rod Milburn, who won the 1972 Olympic gold medal. Both athletes tied and broke numerous indoor and outdoor records in the hurdles. Also at Southern, members of his teams broke the world records in the 440-yard, 880-yard, and mile relays. For two years at San Diego State, he coached Steve Williams, who tied both the 100-yard and 100-meter world records.

In 1975, Hill was a coach with the first team in history to compete against the Peoples Republic of China in Canton, Shanghai, and Peking. Among recent endeavors, Hill spent two weeks in West Africa early in 1979 conducting a continental track course for Olympic coaches. He has also been named team manager for the West Team in the Colorado Sports Festival and is the national high hurdles chairman for the Olympic Development Committee in Colorado Springs.



### Cary Weisiger Assistant Track Coach

Cary Weisiger is a graduate of Duke University, with a B.A. in economics. In addition to his coaching duties, he is a stockbroker at Paine, Webber, Jackson, and Curtis in San Diego.

Weisiger, a three time All-American at Duke, once held the American record in the 1,500 meter run at 3:39.3. His best time in the mile was 3:56.6, and he was ranked fifth in the world in 1963 and seventh in 1962 as a miler. He broke four minutes in the mile ten times.

As a member of the U.S. national team, he toured Europe, New Zealand, Israel, Canada, the West Indies, and the U.S.S.R.

Weisiger served as an officer in the Marine Corps for three years and was the track coach of the Camp Pendleton Marines track team which placed athletes on the U.S. team that competed in Moscow.

### Wes Williams Assistant Track Coach

Wes Williams enters his first season as an Aztec coach in 1979. Williams, who has previously worked as an assistant coach at San Diego's Lincoln and Patrick Henry high schools, will work primarily with runners in the 400 meters and 400 hurdles.

A 1974 SDSU graduate, Williams majored in PE and minored in history while competing for the Aztecs. He is the SDSU record holder in the 440 hurdles and a two-time national indoor champion in the 600 yard dash. He was a member of the AAU International track teams of 1970, '71, '73, '74 and '75. He was ranked fifth internationally and third nationally in the 400 meter hurdles in 1977, and was a two-time All-American in 1969 and 1970 in that event.

Williams is 30, married, and has a nine year old daughter and a five year old son.

### Joe Briski Assistant Track Coach

Joe Briski, the 1978 Aztec track team captain, joins the SDSU coaching staff in this, his first year of coaching. He will be working primarily in the area of field events.

Briski is a 1978 graduate of San Diego State where he majored in both journalism and history. He is the PCAA meet record holder in the hammer throw and won the PCAA championships in 1977 and 1978 in that event. He holds the SDSU record in the hammer throw at 195-3.

He is 23 and single.

### Dave Stiling Team Manager

A sophomore out of Rio Mesa High in Oxnard where he was on the honor roll for four years and was the junior class president...in his second year as the Aztec track team manager...spent two years as a football manager... born July 16, 1959... single... economics major.

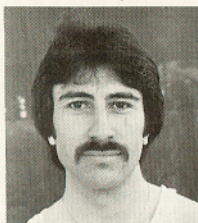
