# Cleveland, Inicki star at Region IV

**SALINAS** — Soquel High's Johnny Cleveland won three events and Harbor's Kelly Inicki was a double winner at the Region IV Track and Field Championships on Saturday at Hartnell College.

Cleveland, the defending state long jump title holder, easily won that event with a leap of 24-feet, ¼-inch — well off his season best of 24-9¼. But the Knight senior made up for that when he blitzed to a 10.6 in the 100 meters to edge Seaside's Sam Crosby going away.

"I've never seen anything like it," said Soquel Coach Mark McConnell as he described the race. "It almost looked like he started to kick over the last 10 meters and that just never happens in that kind of race."

Cleveland, who also won the 200 meters in 21.8 and finished third in the triple jump less than one-half inch behind the winner in 44-1, is now faced with a difficult decision. While the Soquel coaches had been leaning toward entering Cleveland in only the long jump and 200 meters in Friday's Central Coast Section championship meet, his time of 10.8 equals the CCS' season

best, also held by Louis Fortman of Milpitas.

"We'll all just have to get together and decide what we're going to do," said McConnell. "This sort of changes things a little."

In the girls' portion of the meet, Inicki put on a show of her own. Only a freshman, Inicki won the 1600 meters in 5:21.4 after lowering her personal best time by over a minute in winning the two-mile in 11:23.8. Going into the meet, Inicki's best clocking in the event had been a 12:25.0.

The only other individual Santa Cruz County boys winner of the day was Soquel's Marc Goulet, who took the 1600 meters in 4:18.8 — the best time of the season by an area runner in the event. Goulet, who also has run the best two-mile in the county, did not race over that distance so as to concentrate on the 1600 for the CCS.

North Monterey County's Juan Quintero won both hurdles, winning the 110-meter highs in 15.0 and the 300 intermediates in an area-best 38.9.

Other girls individual winners included

Aptos' Jessica Johnson in the 110-meter hurdles in an area-best time of 15.2, Aptos' Lorna Thompson in the 880-yard run in 2:20.0, and Harbor's Kelly Blafield in the 400 meters in 59.4. Johnson, recovering from a recent bout with mononucleosis, is the defending CCS champion in the 200 meters, but did not compete in the event and thus did not qualify for Friday's meet.

The top four individuals and relay teams in each event qualified for the CCS meet, which is to be held at San Jose City College. Trials for the field events are set to begin at 3:30 p.m. with the running trials at 4. The finals are to start at 6:30.

Seaside easily ran away with the boys' team title, piling up 73 points to runnerup Palma's 59. Soquel was a close third with 52 and North Monterey County fourth with 48.

Seaside also took home the girls' team trophy, out-pointing Salinas 60-48. Harbor was third with 41½ and Soquel fourth with 35.

Other CCS boys' qualifiers included Harbor's Andy Wolverton with a third in the 400 meters, Aptos' Mike Alberts with a third in the intermediate hurdles, and So-

quel's Andy McCutcheon with a third in the 1600 with a time of 4:26.6.

Area girls' qualifiers included Soquel's Heidi Skewis, who finished second in the long jump with an effort of 35-8½, teammate Barbara Schmidt with a second in the 100 hurdles in 15.7, Rae Ann Pifferini of the Knights with a 47.7 good for second place in the 300 hurdles and San Lorenzo Valley's Lisa Trask with a second-place leap of 16-7 in the long jump.

Skewis also qualified with a third in the long jump in a personal best 16-1½, while Johnson added a 12.5 in the 100 meters good for a third place. Blafield qualified for a second event with a fourth-place finish in the 200 in 26.2.

Christie Bentley of SLV qualified with a fourth in the 300 hurdles in a school record 48.2, while the Cougar 1600-meter relay team of Sue Egelhoffer, Susie Voak, Kara Hicks and Beth Rome earned a trip to the CCS with a fourth-place finish in a school record 4:14.8.

Although she didn't qualify for the CCS meet, SLV's Rome finished sixth in the 400 meters and set a school record of 1:00.9.
