## Toney, Sexton set <br> meet records in finals

Chris Moura and Roland Anderson won two events apiece and teammate Steve Toney set a meet record Thursday to lead MenloAtherton High School's boys' team to its fifth consecutive Peninsula Athletic League track title at College of San Mateo.
M-A's girls, however, were not as fortunate as Buffy Sexton set a meet record in the shot put to lead Mitls to the PAL title in a highly competitive meet in which the first six teams were separated by only 20 points.

Toney won the pole vault at 15-7, breaking the record set by M-A's Greg Ellis, who vaulted $15-61 / 2$ in the 1980 PAL meet. Toney had a narrow miss at 16-1.
"It's nice to have the league record," Toney said, "but I really

wanted to get over 16 feet. I was way over the bar, but when I let go of the pole and swung my arms back, my chest hit the bar as I was going down. I was very close."
Toney's effort was the only boys' meet record. Sexton accounted for the only girls' mark with a 42 -foot shot put.

Sophomore Shannon Kelly (high jump) and ireshman Yolanda Swindell (mile relay anchor) also contributed to Mills' victory.

Mills' girls won with 68 points, with Aragon second at 60 . San Mateo was next with $58, \mathrm{M}-\mathrm{A}$ and Sequoia tied for fourth with 55 each, and Woodside scored 48. Carlmont had 34, Burlingame and Capuchino 30 each, and Hillsdale 27.

M-A had no trouble winning the boys' meet, winning eight events and scoring 158 points to 89 for runner-up Mills. Aragon was third with 54 , Carlmont had 50 , Sequoia 37, San Mateo 28, Burlingame 22, Hillsdale 17, Woodside 15 and Capuchino 12.
Chris Moura had life bests to win the 800 meters in 1:59.3 and the 300 -meter intermedieate hurdles in 39.8. He came from behind to win both events.
"I was not expecting to win the 800 ," Moura said. "Scott Cox (Woodside) had 30 yards on me 300 yards into the race, and he has a strong finish.
"I was worried at that point and decided I had better make a move. As the race went on I was thinking Cox might already be into his kick. With 100 yards left I could see his back and then he started to die with 50 left and I and my teammate (Aaron Lopez) caught him right at the end."

Moura won the hurdles in the same fashion.
Anderson returned to early season form with a $168-5$ discus toss. He also won the shot put at $55-43 / 4$.

Victor Hudson also contributed for M-A by winning the 400 in 49.9 and anchoring the winning $400-$ meter relay team in 43.1. He finished second to Mills' Skip Johnson, who won the 100 in 10.7 and the 200 in 22.4 , the same time as Hudson.

Other winners in the boys' meet were Mills' Jeff Novitzky in the high jump (6-8); Carlmont's Ben White in the long jump ( $22-111 / 2$ ); Lopez in the mile (4:32.8); Carlmont's Cort Armstrong in the twomile ( $9: 55.8$ ); Aragon's John Eke in the high hurdles (15.2); San Mateo's Gordie Hunt in the triple
jump (42-9); and Aragon in the mile relay (3:29.2).
Woodside's LaShun Peters and San Mateo's Darlene Cluster were the lone double winners in the girls' meet. Peters won with 12.3 and 25.4 marks in the sprints and Cluster won the 800 (2:24.1) and mile ( $5: 23.5$ ). Other winners were Aragon's Jill Parrish in the 400 (59.7); Woodside's Janet Bowie in the two-mile ( $11: 46.8$ ); Burlingame's Sherry Bertram in the 110 -meter low hurdles (15.4); Sequoia's Ada Alger in the 300 low hurdles (46.5); Carlmont's Annette Coleman in the long jump ( $16-51 / 4$ ); Sequoia's Dawn Darbonne in the triple jump (34-7); Mills' Shannon Kelly in the high jump (5-0); and Sequoia's Jennifer Ruff in the discus with a life-best 130-7.
