Section 6. SEEDING PROCEDURES

B. FIELD EVENTS

2. High Jump and Pole Vault:

- a. Athletes will be seeded based on League qualifying marks, with the best mark last. Continuing flights of "five alive" will be used at each height.
- b. Starting heights will be determined by Meet Management after all entries are submitted. Under no circumstances will the opening height be higher than the 40th percentile of League entry marks.
- c. The ~~eight~~ twelve (12) competitors with the best marks will advance to the Finals. ~~Any athlete involved in a tie, which cannot be broken by NFHS rules ("perfect tie"), for the eighth qualifying position will advance to the finals.~~ Normal NFHS tie breaking rule (rule 7-3) will be used to advance to finals. When competition is completed, the area will be closed and no further practice will be allowed.
