| Entry Acceptance | This meet is only open to CIF schools. No out of state schools or clubs are allowed. |
| Entry Limitations | An athlete may not be entered in more than 4 events with a max of 2 individual events. Relay entries count toward the four event maximum. This also includes alternates. Examples: {4 relays} or {3 relays 1 individual event} or {2 relays and 2 individual events} Our goal is to provide as much opportunity as possible across schools while minimizing no shows |
| Entry Procedure | Online registration will be completed through www.athletic.net. No faxed, emailed or phoned entries will be accepted. Please adhere to the deadlines above. |
| Entry Fees | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • \$10 per athlete entered • There is no team fee cap • Entry fees are based on final entries and will not be adjusted for scratches or no-shows for any reason <p>Please note:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The entry deadline is firm • Do not request scratches after the scratch deadline, as heats and lanes will already be seeded • Teams that enter but do not attend the meet will still be responsible for the full entry fee • If payment is not made at this meet, the balance must be paid at your next meet with us or an invoice will be sent to your school <p>Payment Information</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Payment is due at packet pickup • Accepted forms of payment: school check or cash only • Make checks payable to Wilcox Dads, Grads, and Moms • Purchase orders and personal checks will not be accepted • Please do not mail payment in advance • Team packets will not be released without payment <p>If payment is forgotten, there are banks located nearby on Stevens Creek Blvd.</p> |

Meet Information

Awards

Awards will be given as outlined below:

- **T-shirts** will be awarded to the **top three (3) finishers** in each event
- **Trophies** will be awarded to the **Most Outstanding Track Event** athlete in each gender
- **Trophies** will be awarded to the **Most Outstanding Field Event** athlete in each gender

Event awards may be picked up at the awards station approximately 10 minutes after the conclusion of the event, once results are final. The awards station will be located between the shed and stands near the finish line.

Most Outstanding awards will be selected by the Games Committee at the conclusion of the meet. If an athlete is not present to receive a Most Outstanding award, the trophy will be mailed to the school.

Coaching Access

Coaches may provide verbal coaching **from outside the perimeter of the track**.

Coaching is not permitted in the main start/finish line area.

Athletes are not permitted to cross the track at any time to receive coaching.

No coaches are permitted on the infield at any time, including for instructional or observational purposes. Infield access is restricted to competitors in the event, meet officials, and authorized personnel only.

Coaches Wristbands

Teams will receive one (1) coach's wristband for every ten (10) athletes entered, up to a maximum of ten (10) wristbands per team. Wristbands will be included in team packets at packet pickup. Wristbands serve as admission to the facility. Lost wristbands will not be replaced. Additional coaches will be required to purchase a ticket.

Electronic Devices

Please refrain from using electronic devices in the warm-up and competition areas for safety purposes.

Entry Marks

Speculative marks are permitted and will be accepted on an honor system. Final heat sheets will list speculative marks as submitted, so please use fair and accurate marks when entering athletes. Events will be seeded, and running event lanes will be assigned, based on the marks submitted. No changes will be accepted after the close of entries or at the meet.

Facility Access

Access to the De Anza College Stadium will begin 1 hour prior to the first event.

| Packets | Team packets will include wristbands for coaches and athletes in PE 673. For the updated schedule, and heat sheets visit www.deanzasports.com/sports/mtrack/meet_info |
| Restrooms | Restrooms will be available outside the southeast corner of the track. There are no shower or changing facilities available. |
| Parking | Parking is free and available in all lots. Pay close attention to signage; staff parking, event parking etc. This meet information was written and posted prior to the possibility of events being added to the campus the same day as our competition. |
| Practice | The De Anza College track and field facility will not be open for practice prior to the meet. |
| Preferred Lanes | 5-6-4-7-3-8-2-9-1 for preregistered athletes. Walk up registration will fill out any open lanes. |
| Scoring | This is a non-scored meet. |
| Sports Medicine | Trainers will be available near the finish line for emergencies only. No other athletic training services will be provided. |
| Spike Check | Only 1/4" pyramid spikes are permitted (3/8" recessed pyramid spikes are permitted for High Jump & Javelin). No needles. Please help us preserve the facilities with the appropriate spikes. |
| Tape | Only white athletic tape may be used for any markings on the track. No other tape is permitted. Chalk is prohibited for any markings, and athletes using chalk will be disqualified. |
| Team Camps | Team camps may be set up on the soccer field only. The track, field seating, and standing areas surrounding the track are reserved for spectator use and may not be used for team camps. Camps are not permitted along stadium walkways. Ample space is available in the soccer field and warm-up area. |
| Warm-ups | <p>Running Events: Please bring your own batons for relay warm-ups and starting blocks for warm-ups. Limited hurdles will be available in the warm-up area on the soccer field. The soccer field will serve as the primary area for warm-ups and cool-downs. Please be mindful of designated areas on the soccer field for team camps and warm-up strides.</p> <p>Field Events: Field event athletes will have access to their event sites approximately 30 minutes prior to the scheduled start of competition. Throwing events will roll directly into the next listed gender "to follow." Athletes should remain near the event site once the preceding competition concludes. If all athletes are present and prepared, officials may begin competition early; however, the posted warm-up window will not be shortened for late arrivals.</p> |
| Weather Policy | The meet will run rain or shine. |
| Weight-Room | No weight room access. |
| Weigh-Ins | Implement inspections will be held in the Track & Field equipment shed, at the southwest corner. Inspections will begin ~1.5 hours prior to the scheduled start of competition. Implements will be transported to the event site 35 minutes prior to the scheduled start of competition. |
