The meet is scheduled to go from 3:30 p.m. until it is finished. With any luck at all, we could finish by 10:00 p.m. With no luck, the meet could go until midnight. Be prepared to stay the entire time. Officials don't get to go home early.

Long & Triple Jump

Well, Martha, it's time again:

Your crew: Phil Fung, Ben Bromley, Mike Paik

1. Order of jumps: 4:00 to 5:30 --GFS Long Jump
5:30 to 7:00 -- GV Long Jump
7:00 to ? -- BFS Triple Jump

These are broad parameters, and you may speed things up at your discretion. I tend to think that there will be precious few GFS jumpers, so that event may be done with quicker. As always, you have the Press Booth nearby to transmit your decisions to the assembled populace.

2. Each jumper gets three (3) attempts.

3. Please note that girls only long jump; boys only triple jump. Hopefully this too will speed things up.

assumptions: entries yield the equivalent number of heats as last year
timely delivery of athletes from bullpen to starting line
orderly results gathering at finish line

Notes: There is some time squeezing due to trying to stick to increments of 5 minutes. The hurdle moving will not take all the time allotted, so there is some stretch time there. The mile relays, especially with the younger girls, will take longer than 5 minutes, so there is squeeze time there. Again, the crucial spots (finish line and bullpen) are areas that we are strong in, so this schedule has some basis in reality. We should probably keep this internal, and not publish it, as any delay would throw the whole thing off. This is essentially a reference for ourselves to keep the meet running along briskly.
