

Palo Alto preps win cross country meet ^{10/5/55}

Palo Alto, paced by Ron Larrieu's 9:31 winning time, won the opening meet of the prep cross country season yesterday at Golden Gate Park in San Francisco.

The Vikings lead with 26 points followed by Washington of San Francisco with 42 and James Lick of San Jose, 57.

Palo Alto wins cross country ^{12/14/55}

Palo Alto's cross country team led by Ron Larrieu, won the San Jose Center meet held at the San Jose Country Club yesterday.

Larrieu took first place in the meet, covering the one and 62/100 mile course in 8:14.8. Palo Alto scored 18 points to 44 for second place Bellarmine and 69 for third place Santa Clara.

Don Lee of Lincoln was second in the run in 8:27. Other Viking clockings were 8:28 by John Morrison, 8:40 by Tom Cathcart, 8:44 by Bill Wittson.

Steve Storey led Palo Alto in the novice division with a 9:09 clocking and Craig Duncan topped the Vikes in the freshman competition with 9:30.

Palo Alto's cross country team, rated the best in the nation's by Coach Forrest Jamieson, defeated two other opponents in a meet yesterday at San Jose.

Led by Ron Larrieu's record 9:46.8 timing, the Vikings scored 15 points to 40 for James Lick of San Jose. Washington of Centerville placed third with 75 points.

Three other Vikings—Tom Cathcart, John Morrison and Bill Whitson—trailed Larrieu in the center meet.
