Culver City Near Record

Culver City, Calif., high school just missed the team record and Danny Murphy of Mira Costa, Manhattan Beach, Calif., set a national prep record to feature the fourth annual national two-mile team race postal competition under the sponsorship of Track & Field News.

Bill O'Rourke's Culver City quintet averaged 9:52, 3 in running 49:21, 2. Mira Costa set the record at 49:20. 6 last year and finished second this time with 49:28.8. In the roughest competition yet, Clayton Valley of Concord, Calif. was third with 49:51.6, the fifth team in history to break the magic 50 minutes.

Murphy won individual honors with 9:24, 8 but his new national high school record is 9:25.5. His 9:24.8 was made against no outside competition and cannot be considered for approval as a national mark. But the 9:25.5, turned in in a triangular meet where Mira Costa won its second place, undoubtedly will be recognized, replacing the 9:26.5 set by Dave Boore of Los Altos, Calif., in 1959.

A close second was the Culver City leadman, Doug Calhoun, who was under 9:30 twice with a best of 9:27.3. Eleven others bettered 9:45 and 39 were

under 10 minutes, an increase over the record 27 of 1959.

Fifteen states and 82 schools competed. Both represented new highs,

bettering the figures of 12 and 59 set last year.
