Smooth striding Arvid Kretz led a 1-2-3 Stanford finish as the Indians swept by the Bruins on their home course. Arvid's time of 29:52 sliced 26 seconds off the UCLA course record. Stanford runners broke the race wide open the second time up Sunset Blvd., as UCLA's Neil Sybert lost contact with Kretz, Kardong, and Coe. Duncan Macdonald again produced another big effort at the longer distance and finished 4th, only 1 second short of the old record. The Washington weather front did not reach the LA basin, and the race was run under a clear southern California sky.
