

#### OUTLOOK

Three veteran runners will bolster the 1974 Stanford cross country efforts under the direction of Head Coach Marshall Clark. With qualifying for the NCAA Championships their goal, the Cardinal harriers are intent upon bettering their sixth place Pac-8 finish of a year ago. The top three teams in the conference advance to national competition.

Juniors Tony Sandoval (Los Alamos, N.M.) and Jack Bellah (Los Gatos, Calif.) teamed with Captain Mark McConnell (Santa Cruz, Calif.) supply Coach Clark with three of Stanford's all-time top six-milers. Last season, Sandoval captured medals at the Fresno Invitational, a four-way meet with Cal, West Valley, and San Jose State, as well as at a dual meet with Long Beach State. The 5-7, 120-pounder placed ninth in the Pac-8 run, and fortieth among a strong field of runners in the NCAA Championships.

Sandoval holds the Stanford school record

over six miles at 29:03.0. Teammate Bellah is eighth on the Cardinal all-time list with 29:40 over the distance while McConnell posted a 29:47 time in 1972, placing him tenth in the records book.

Freshman Stacy Geiken, a Palo Alto native, heads the roster of newcomers. A 6-2, 145-pound product of Cubberley High, Geiken placed second in the Central Coast Two-Mile earlier this year.

Conference competition could be at an all-time high this season with seven schools fielding exceptional teams. Oregon finished first in the NCAA last year, with Washington State close behind at third. WSU's John Ngeno, a junior from Kenya, won the 1974 NCAA track six-mile and the '72 Pac-8 cross country events. Oregon is minus Steve Prefontaine, but returns Paul Geis, the '74 NCAA 3-mile winner.

Stanford will host the Pac-8 Championships again this year, slated for November 16. Prior to that, the Cards will participate in three invitationals, including the Stanford meet October 19.
