

CND's women outrace Stanford

BELMONT — For the first time ever, both College of Notre Dame's cross country teams — men and women — won team championships in the same meet.

That meet happened to be the College of Notre Dame's own Argonaut Invitational on the Crystal Springs course Saturday.

Notre Dame's mens' team collected 27 points to down Fresno Pacific (66), Stanford (68) and UC Davis (94).

In the womens' race, the Argonauts won with 48 points to edge the California JV's (92) and Cal State-San Bernadino (95).

CND's Jesus Gutierrez was second in the five mile race in 26:49. Rico Aparicio followed in 27:07 and Half Moon Bay High grad Fernando Villegas was fourth in 27:25. Dan Fisher was sixth in 27:34.

"Dan set the tone for the whole race," CND Coach Mike Ipsen said. "He was our leading runner after two miles and pressured our other guys into catching him."

The top four women runners were within 14 seconds of each other and Karla Witthar, the Argonauts' fifth runner, is clos-

ing the gap. Witthar ran with 1:33 of the top four runners, a 45-second improvement since the start of the season.

Menlo-Atherton High grads Susan Horstmeyer and Sandrine deMarval led the Argonauts with third- and fourth-place finishes, respectively. Horstmeyer went the 5,000-meter course in 18:29. DeMarval went 18:29. HMB alumna Lorena Ferreira was seventh in 18:41 and Tennessee's Donna McKinnon was eighth in 18:43. Witthar was 26th in 20:16.
