

CALIFORNIA HIGH SCHOOL CHAMPIONSHIPS

1. MANAGEMENT

The CIF/Reebok California High School Cross-Country Championships shall be managed by the State CIF which will have final authority and responsibility for the Championships.

3. DATE & SITE

Saturday, November 26, 1988 - Woodward Park, Fresno, CA

Note: Competitors will not leave school on the day preceding the competition prior to the close of the school day unless travel requires two days. If travel requirements warrant, schools may petition their section CIF office for the additional day. Violation of this regulation may result in disqualification.

4. CLASSIFICATION SYSTEM

The CIF/Reebok Cross Country Championships shall be conducted in three divisions for both boys and girls - Divisions I, II, III. CIF Section Commissioners are responsible for insuring that schools entering the Championships meet the following enrollment criteria:

Division I - Large Schools - 1600 and above
Division II - Medium Schools - 700 to 1599
Division III - Small Schools - 699 & under

The procedures adopted by the State CIF Competion Committee to determine enrollment by C-BED figures shall be utilized for the State Cross Country Championships. Three-year schools shall double 10th grade enrollment and then add that number to the 11th and 12th enrollment figures for a total. Single Gender schools enrollment shall be doubled.

Each school participating in the state playoffs must play in the division which corresponds to their school classification.

6. COURSE AND RUNNING SURFACE

- a. All races will be 5000 meters
- b. The course is in Woodward Park on hard packed dirt trails with some grass and asphalt. It has mild ups and downs over rolling hills with one steep short hill.
- c. Many major cross-country meets have been run on this course. (Kinney Meet, State J.C., Regional and District N.C.A.A. Meets).
- d. No spikes are allowed on this course.
- e. Alternate course is on the asphalt roads in Woodward Park.
- f. Meet will be run RAIN OR SHINE!!! There is a rain course available at Woodward Park if conditions warrant its use.

Qualifications from sectional competition to the State Cross Country Meet is based upon team as well as <u>individual place</u> finish.

Qualifying teams plus the top five highest placed individuals (not on a qualifying team) in each division will qualify from section to state meet finals.

Note: A team consists of 5 to 7 runners. Section Commissioners: Please fill your allocation of entries in case of declinations by qualified team or individuals.

Entries must be called in no later than Sunday, November 20, (FAX # 209-674-6038..24 hour service) by each CIF Section's authorized representative.

8. UNIFORMS

All athletes competing in the championships must wear their high school uniform. Uniforms of all team members must be identical. No other uniform may be worn during warm-ups, the competition, or on the victory stand. Unless specifically approved by meet management, the wearing of sweatsuits, tee shirts, or any clothing representing any organization, corporation or business, college or university is strictly prohibited and may result in disqualification.

9. OFFICIAL RULES

1988 National Federation Cross-Country Rules (located in Track and Field Rule Book) are official and will be enforced.

Rule 307 of the By-Laws will be enforced: "All individual runners and teams must be accompanied by a certified person from the school district."

10. RESTROOMS AND LOCKER ROOMS

Restrooms are located throughout the park, but please come dressed to run.

11. COACHES PACKETS

The coach of all qualified teams and individuals may pick up their packets on Friday, November 25, 1988 at Woodward Park from 3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. and the Picadilly-University Inn Headquarters, from 7:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. OR at Woodward Park after 8:00 a.m. on Saturday, November 26, 1988. Only the Coaches names that appear on the section qualifying entry form will be allowed to receive that school's packet.

12. SCORING PROCEDURES

- (a) Each coach will receive a special color-coded name tag for each runner. Each tag will have pertinent information on it. The tags must be worn by each runner and will be removed in the finish chute at the conclusion of each race. If you find any information on the tag that is not correct, contact the Meet Director at once.
- (b) Meet results will be posted after each awards ceremony. Copies of typed results will be available to each school after each awards ceremony. (Two to each school.)
- (c) Scoring will be in compliance with the 1988 National Federation Rules ((Five (5) score and Two (2) displace).

13. ENTRANCE/PARKING/CONCESSIONS

- (a) Entrance to Woodward Park will be at the NORTH GATE ONLY (See Map).
- (b) Donation/Admission charges: ADULTS - \$4.00; CHILDREN - \$2.50
- (c) Please park in designated areas marked by color of Parking Pass.
- (d) A concession stand will be available at the park. Coaches and athletes please plan to provide your own lunch.
- (e) CIF/REEBOK will have a souvenir concession stand open from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. They will have T-Shirts, Sweat Shirts, Pins, and other cross country material on sale. Supply is limited to those on hand and at Picadilly Inn-University on Friday, November 25, 1988, evening 7:00 p.m. 10:00 p.m.

14. AWARDS

- (a) TEAM AWARDS Plaques for champion and runner up/team medals 1st through 7th for championship team and runner up.
- (b) INDIVIDUAL AWARDS Individual medals 1st through 10th runner, each division.
- (c) PLAQUES will be awarded to individual champions in each division (boys and girls).
- (d) CERTIFICATES will be awarded to all participants.

15. HOSPITALITY COACHES AND PRESS ROOM

Friday night (11/25/88), PICADILLY INN-UNIVERSITY from 7:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. Place to meet other coaches, runners and press. Refreshments will be available and team packets can be picked up at that time.

16. SOUVENIR PROGRAM

A quality souvenir program will be available for purchase at Woodward Park. The program will include photos and information on the outstanding athletes in the State.

17. MEDIA INFORMATION
