In their only meeting this season, St. Francis High and Leigh staged one of the most exciting girls cross-country duals of the season.

They tied, 32-32, in the third and final Crystal Springs center meet of the season, but the sixth runner for St. Francis finished far ahead of Leigh's to give the tie-breaking victory to the Lancers.

St. Francis and Leigh are regarded as two of the top four teams in the Central Coast Section (along with Mills and Los Gatos), but will not meet in the postseason because St. Francis competes in Division III and Leigh in Division II.

Leigh's Kate Sweeney ran the third-fastest time on the 2.9-mile Crystal Springs course this year to win in 18:55. Audrey Muller of Aragon was a distant second in 20:41.

St. Francis was paced by Laura Demmelmaier in 20:27, leading a 3-4-7-12-13 finish. Leigh countered with 1-5-6-10-16, but they each added up to 32 points after runners from incomplete teams were weeded out of the scoring.

The Lancers' top six finished within 41 seconds of each other.

In the boys race, Stuart Ellington of Milpitas continued his unbeaten season with a victory in

15:27, to win by 33 seconds.

Freshman Colin Bailey led Mountain View (102 points) to a surprising second-place team finish behind Leigh (29) in the 13team race. Bailey was 12th in 17:00. Carlmont was third.
