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APPLICATION FOR SCHOLASTIC CHAMPIONSHIP TEAM CONSIDERATION

I, the undersigned principal, hereby submit for consideration the SCHOLASTIC CHAMPIONSHIP TEAM AWARD in the Varsity sport indicated below.

As required by the criteria, each roster member of the team as of the end of the grading period indicated was included in the computation of the collective grade point average of the team. The computation was based upon the following point values:

- A=4.0; B=3.0; C=2.0; D=1.0; F=0.0;
- Incomplete = NOT TO BE CONSIDERED;
- + and/or - grades = NOT TO BE CONSIDERED;
- Pass/Fail = NOT TO BE CONSIDERED;
- AP/and/or honors courses = NO ADDED GRADE POINTS.

The collective G.P.A. of the team was determined as follows:

1. For each and all roster members, tally grades A through F, for the grading period.
2. Total all A through F grades by letter grade.
3. Multiply point values above times number of each letter grade.
4. Total point values from #3, above.
5. Divide by total number of letter grades considered, carry to 4 places.


