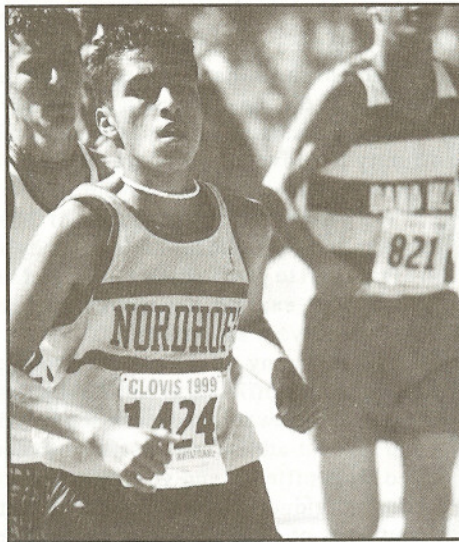

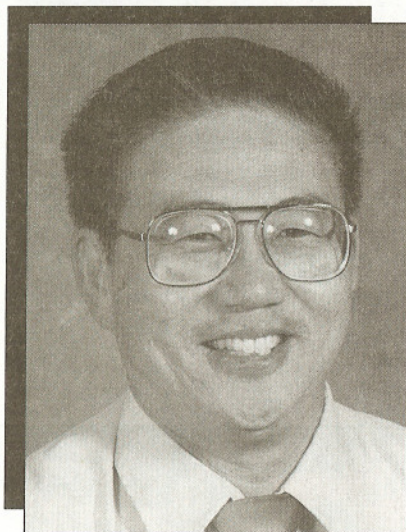

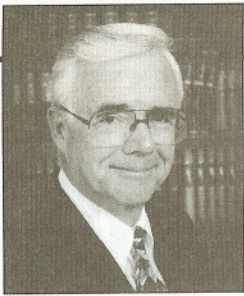

Championship History

In existence since 1914, the CIF offers state championships in five different sports; cross country, girls' volleyball, wrestling, basketball, track and field, with regional action in golf and tennis.

The CIF State Cross Country Championships were the newest edition to the state championship fold in 1987 and have been held annually at Woodward Park, Fresno.

1998 Championships

The Nordhoff High School girls and boys team each won a championship to combine for an unbelievable 11 overall titles. The boys team won its sixth crown to join McFarland as teams with the most titles. The girls extended their record to five championships in the girls' field. The team action was also highlighted by University (SF) girls who challenged their own record of 18 points in the Division V title run and won a third straight title. Kira Morser set an individual Division V record for University with a time of 18:20.

Morser joined Sara Bei, of Montgomery Santa Rosa with two titles apiece. Bei took the Division III title in 17:22 and, in 1999, will look to join Julia Stamps and Deena Drossin as the only girls with three individual titles.

1997 Championships

The girls' team from University High School (San Francisco) set an all-time record for points scored (18) en route to its second straight Division V title. Two other teams distinguished themselves as both the Jesuit (Carmichael) boys' team and the Nordhoff (Ojai) boys' team won their fifth overall titles.

Individually, Isaish Festa of Morro Bay won his second championship and Elaine Canchola of Nordhoff took her second overall title. In the process of winning the Division IV crown, Festa set a divisional record of 15:18. Kira Morser of University also set the individual standard in Division V (18:47).

1996 Championships

The McFarland High boys' cross country team accomplished a feat that no other school in state championships history has accomplished - winning five straight titles. McFarland bested its own record of 40 points with 29 to claim the Division V CIF State Championship at the 10th annual event.

While McFarland highlighted team competition, Julia Stamps was again an individual standout. Stamps broke her own Division I record with a sizzling 16:43 finish for her third title and fifth overall including track and field. The prior year, Stamps had set the Division I mark of 16:45 to become the first girl in California history to topple the 17-minute mark.

Carondelet's Kristen Gordon broke the Division III record with a time of 17:17 in that race. Elaine Canchola of Nordhoff had set the record of 17:36 the previous year.

Behind Canchola's second place finish in Division IV, the Nordhoff girls claimed their fourth overall title moving the Rangers past Palos Verdes, Agoura and Newport Harbor for the most titles ever won in girls' competition.

1995 Championship

Junior Julia Stamps was again a headliner as the Santa Rosa High star easily eclipsed her own mark and set a course record of 16:45 and Nordhoff Ojai boys' and girls' each garnered CIF State Championships at the 1995 championships.

Coach Ken Reeves saw his Nordhoff boys' team take their fourth state championships and his girls' team with their third title - a combined seven for both

squads.

McFarland boys' proceeded to win the Division IV title to move past Nordhoff and Jesuit with five overall championships, including four straight (1992-95).

It was a record-setting day as five state marks were erased. Besides Stamps, Elaine Canchola (Nordhoff High) also set an individual record of 17:36 - 15 seconds better than the previous mark of 17:51 by Katie McCandless of Castilleja.

Three team records were set as Louisville High took its first title in Division IV girls' competition. Nordhoff bested Sherman Indian High's mark of 58 points with 35 in the Division III boys' team race and McFarland broke its own record of 61 points with 40 in the Division IV boys' competition.

1994 Championships

Under wet and muddy conditions, Stamps turned in perhaps the finest performance ever in the state cross country championships. Despite the conditions, Stamps still managed to set a record, crossing the chute in 17:06 to win the Division I title.

Other highlights from 1994 included Heather Garritson's (sister of Carrie) individual title in the Division III girls' race. Garritson, a freshman at Buena Park High, outdistanced another freshman - Elaine Canchola of Nordhoff Ojai (18:01-18:07) - to take the title. Carrie and Heather become the first sister combination to win state crowns in cross country. Carrie won titles for Rim of the World Lake Arrowhead in 1990 (Division III) and for Buena Park in 1993 (Division II).

Amy Skieresz of Agoura took her second straight title in 1994, this time in Division II, with a finish of 18:12. Skieresz was the Division I champ in 1993. Galvin Gonzalez of McFarland and Kristen Schreiber of Miramonte Orind were also repeat champs.

In the 1994 team competition, McFarland claimed its fourth title. Thousand Oaks boys were another highlight

winning their second straight championship in Division I with an amazing 38 points. Thousand Oaks had three boys - Jeff Fischer (3rd), Keith O'Doherty (6th) and Kevin Marsden (9th) - in the top 10.

1993 Championships

Thousand Oaks High, behind the running of Jeff Fischer and Kevin

off a double, taking both the boys' and girls' Division IV team crowns.

Shelley Taylor of Edison and Daniel Das Neves of Helix both emerged with individual titles in 1991.

1990 Championships

The state cross country championships expanded to include four divisions in 1990. The emergence of Hart

with 54 points in Division III. Newport Harbor (girls Division II) and Palos Verdes (girls Division I) were repeat champions on the team side.

1987 Championships

In its first year of existence in 1987, Bryan Dameworth of Agoura outdistanced Goshu Tadese of Crawford (15:12-15:13) for his first of what turned out to be a record three championships.

Deena Drossin, also of Agoura, won the first of her three titles as well. Other individual winners that first year were Scott Hempel of Walnut in Division II who took his first of two championships (15:22.1), Reggie Williams in Division III (15:29), Kira Jorgensen of Rancho Buena Vista in Division II girls (17:34) - her first of two straight titles, and Katy McCandless of Castilleja in Division III (17:51).

In the team competition, the Arroyo boys behind the efforts of Jamie Ortega (4th), Jeff Gilkey (6th) and Luis Quintana (7th) ran away with the Division I title with 41 points, while Palos Verdes won the first of three straight championships in the Division I girls competition. Ashley Black, a sixth place finisher, was an individual standout for Palos Verdes.

General Notes

Since its beginnings, only three individuals have won three championships. Interestingly, two of those competed for Agoura High - Dameworth (boys) and Drossin (girls) while the other was Santa Rosa's Julia Stamps.

Six boys and 11 girls have won two individual titles apiece. For the boys' two-time winners are Dameworth, Hempel of Walnut, Wilson of Newbury Park, Gonzalez of McFarland, Lynbrook High's Jason Balkman, Festa of Morro Bay.

Two-time individual champs for the girls include Glusac of Fallbrook, Jorgensen of Rancho Buena Vista, Skieresz of Agoura, Carrie Garritson of Rim of the World and Buena Park, Kristen Schreiber of Miramonte Orinda, Annie Ebner of St. Lucy's, Canchola of Nordhoff, Bei of Montgomery and University's Morser.

McFarland and Nordhoff lead the way with six team crowns in boys' competition. While Nordhoff Ojai leads the girls' with five titles. Jesuit has garnered five championships in the boys' competition, while Palos Verdes, Agoura, Newport Harbor, Yucaipa and University have three girls' team titles. Palos Verdes High combined with Rolling Hills and Miraleste to form Peninsula in 1991.



Marsden, turned in a fantastic team finish with a record 23 points to win the 1993 Division I boys' championships.

Mebraton Keflezig turned in an outstanding effort in winning an individual title in Division I (15:02) and Amy Skieresz won her first title in the girls' Division I race (17:49). Matt Farley of Jesuit Carmichael High edged Devin Elizando of Mission Bay in the Division II boys' race. That proved significant as Jesuit beat Mission Bay by one point (70-71) to win the Division II team title.

Galvan Gonzalez, an individual titlist, paced McFarland to another title in Division IV.

1992 Championships

McFarland High boys took the first of five straight state championships in 1992. Fallbrook's Milena Glusac took her second straight title just missing her personal best with a 17:14. Nordhoff finished second in both the boys' and girls' Division IV competition.

1991 Championships

Fallbrook High's Glusac set a Division I girls' record with a time of 17:13 to win the 1991 individual title in that division. Glusac's mark held until Stamps' broke it in 1994.

Hart boys and Agoura girls both repeated as team champions in Division I. Newport Harbor, in Division III girls, won its third CIF State Championship and Nordhoff Ojai pulled

High School, which won the Division I boys championship (58 points) was one of the stories. Hart went on to win three straight titles with standouts like Keith Grossman and Brett Strahan leading the way.

The Agoura girls' team also broke through with its first championship in 1990 with a record 41 points. San Pasqual High took a rare double winning both the Division II boys' and girls' state championships. The 38 points for the San Pasqual girls' team is still a record. La Jolla High girls also set a record with 31 points in winning the Division III title. Carrie Garritson of Rim of the World High and Jeff Wilson of Newbury Park, both took the first of their two individual titles.

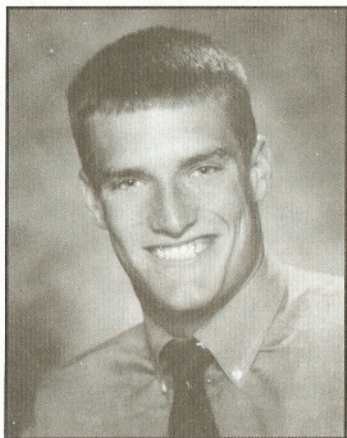
1989 Championships

Dameworth again played a starring role at the 1989 meet, setting a Division I record of 14:45 en route to his third individual title. Dameworth outdistanced Luis Quintana of Arroyo Grande (14:59). Deena Drossin of Agoura won her second title, but Palos Verdes edged Agoura (65-75) for its third team title. Bret Harte High repeated as team titlists in the Division III girls' final.

1988 Championships

There were three repeat winners at the 1988 meet; Dameworth in Division I boys (15:03.2), Scott Hempel in Division II boys (15:15) and Kira Jorgensen in Division I girls (17:42). Bret Harte girls won the first of its two state titles

Van Löben Sels, Rooney Statewide Honorees

Julie Van Löben Sels of McClatchy High School and Kevin Rooney of St. Mary's High School in Stockton have been selected as the statewide fall CIF Spirit of Sport Award honorees. Both will be honored with plaques at their school and at the State CIF Federated Council dinner on May 5, 1999.

The CIF Spirit of Sport Award was established last year as a way to recognize and honor student-athletes who are positive role models within their school and communities.

The CIF Sportsmanship Citizenship Committee selects winners based primarily on demonstrated principles of good sportsmanship, school and community service, and leadership. Sportsmanship counts for 50 percent of the total score with 25 percent for community service and 25 percent for leadership. Nominations are made by CIF member high schools.

"This is a most impressive group of young students," said Jack Hayes, CIF executive director. "They are an integral part of what sport is all about - fair play, integrity and respect for teammates, coaches, officials and opponents."

Frank Anderson, co-principal at El Molino High School and the chairman of the Sportsmanship/Citizenship Committee said: "We are very pleased to have the opportunity to recognize these student-athletes who demonstrate the ideals of sportsmanship. They are role models for all who are involved in high school athletics and it is important that they be recognized as such. Their achievements and their positive attitudes toward athletic competition re-affirm our belief that interscholastic athletics can be a positive and valuable learning experience for our students."

Van Löben Sels, McClatchy High School

Van Löben Sels is a well-rounded student, giving her time to many community projects, and excelling in academics and athletics. Ranked first in a class of 489 students, Van Löben Sels has compiled a cumulative 4.17 grade point average while competing in golf and basketball. Nominated for the prestigious Wendy's High School Heisman Award, she has been a member of the varsity golf team for four years and was an All-Metro Leaguer in basketball, where she was team captain last season and team MVP. She is also a four-year member and

flutist on the McClatchy High marching band and concert band and, in August of 1998, she was part of a tour group at the National Flute Convention in Phoenix, Arizona. Her leadership skills are also apparent. Van Löben Sels was selected for the 1999 National Youth Leadership Forum held in Washington D.C. and was selected to represent McClatchy at a Women's Leadership Conference co-sponsored by Tierra del Oro Council. Her community service includes cleaning beaches in Santa Cruz, service at an AIDS drop-in shelter, preparing Thanksgiving food baskets for Parkside Community Church, coaching basketball at Girls Scouts sports events, fundraisers efforts for her church, and preparing food for a homeless shelter in Santa Cruz.

Rod Hollander, a counselor at McClatchy said: "Van Löben Sels exhibits true sportsmanship in all aspects of her life. She competes to the highest level of her ability at all times. On the court she conducts herself impeccably. I have never seen her react in a negative manner in any game situation. If she makes a mistake, she tries harder. If a teammate makes a mistake, she is always encouraging, not disparaging. She epitomizes the attitude educators try to instill in our student-athletes."

Kevin James Rooney, St. Mary's High School

An outstanding student, athlete and leader at St. Mary's High School, Rooney has served as team captain for both his football and basketball teams. As a junior he was an all-league honorable mention in football and he has been a member of league champions in three sports — football, basketball and baseball. In addition, Rooney has maintained a 4.0 grade point average and is currently the Student Body Vice President and senate president at St. Mary's. He served as his junior class vice president and president of his freshman class. Rooney is the founder and president of the Friends of Special Olympics at St. Mary's High School, and organizes a group of 100 students who work with Special Olympic Events throughout the year. He also works in the mentor program at St. Mary's and has volunteered his time to assemble playground equipment in Mexico, deliver Thanksgiving and Christmas food and gift packages through the student council, works with the campus ministry program, and contributed time to the school's annual blood drive. In addition, he was selected as Homecoming King.

John Gustorf, a basketball coach and teacher at St. Mary's High School said: "Kevin has tremendous respect for coaches, fellow athletes, officials, and opponents. He is one of the very few athletes that I regularly see compliment an opponent for a good effort, win or lose, and instinctively reach for an opposing player that has fallen to the floor. Kevin plays each game with the same demeanor. He is physical, tough and has heart, but never loses sight of the big picture."

CIF EDUCATIONAL AND RECOGNITION PROGRAMS

COACHING EDUCATION PROGRAM

A CIF Coaching Education program is now in place with more than 7,000 coaches trained statewide. In addition, successful legislation has been written providing for matching funds for schools who meet a determined criteria. In September 1998 former Governor Pete Wilson signed legislation (AB2741) which allocates \$1 million for the CIF Coaching Education Program. Planned expansion for the program include units on equity, coaching the opposite gender, and sportsmanship to be developed in the coaching education package. In addition, the CIF will offer reduced price training aimed at private schools that can't apply for state funding. OFFICIALS ACCREDITATION

A model and criteria for accreditation of officials associations has been developed and accreditation team members have been trained. To date, 120 organizations have been accredited. Initiation of training for officials is

among the next steps for this program.

CIF SCHOLAR ATHLETE OF THE YEAR

This prestigious program, which is highly acclaimed by the State Legislature, recognizes one male and one female statewide CIF Scholar-Athlete of the Year. Each winner is honored with a monetary award, a plaque recognizing their achievements and with a trip to the State Capitol in Sacramento where they meet with members of the legislature and the assembly. Nominations are sent to principals in early January and deadlines for receiving the scholar-athlete packets will be mid-March. Each school may nominate as many scholar-athletes as they wish and a selection committee will pick the winners. CIF SPORTSMANSHIP/CITIZENSHIP PROGRAMS

This past year, the CIF developed a program to foster and award exemplary sportsmanship/citizenship. Currently, the CIF Sportsmanship/Citizenship program recognizes statewide winners per each season of sport. One male and one female are selected from nominations received from member schools. Additionally, this program honors individuals at each state championship event. Included is a school-based awards program, whereby 12 CIF Sportsmanship/Citizenship certificates are mailed to each school. Each school can award these as they deem appropriate to parents, coaches, student-athletes, cheerleaders, or even opponents who display exemplary sportsmanship/citizenship. Bei Headlines Talented Group of Individuals: Nordhoff, University Again in Team Hunt

The crown jewel that is always pleasantly sitting at the end of every California High School Cross-Country season is the CIF State Meet at Fresno's Woodward Park, with the annual Thanksgiving weekend trip treasured by all involved, spectators or otherwise. 1999 will be no exception, with the Golden State's schools and individual participants finishing out the century with a flock of great races! We will see many judged among the entire country's best here this weekend, so pick your viewing spots, and enjoy!

The Girls Division II contest will start the day off. A good group from around the State has battled all season long for top spot here! Foothill (Santa Ana SS), Southern Section champs in a close run over Santa Margarita (Rancho SM SS), and Brea-Olinda (Brea SS), emerged early in the season and has proven itself in runs a long distance from home, racing to a fine win in their Divisional race at the Stanford Invitational in October. Foothill is a pack team, with Lori Mann (Santa Margarita) State runner-up here individually last Fall, and Jenny Thune (Brea) strong individuals leading their squads. La Jolla (SD) won big in its Section Meet, with a good third place Team Sweeps race at the Mt. SAC Invite. Antioch (NCS) has been very strong in its area this year, with soph Janie Nolan runner-up to Sara Bei in the Section race. Vacaville (SJ), with top individual Robyn Stevens (third last year individually Division II) was a big Sac Joaquin winner, with Newport Harbor (Newport Beach SS) the other strong Southern Section qualifier, led by Section individual winner Amber Steen.

Sara Bei (Montgomery, Santa Rosa NCS), felt by many to be the nation's top individual runner, will start our day, with the junior already a two-time State Champ, last year taking Division III. Desiree Davila (Hilltop, Chula Vista SD) was fourth here last year and won her Section race, with Laura Jakosky (Agoura SS) sixth individually last year here and second in her Section run. Christine Eckstaedt (El Modena, Or-

ange SS) is peaking nicely, with Kelly Dahl (Wood, Vacaville) seventh here last year individually.

The Girls Division III contest is led by the State's most improved program. San Lorenzo Valley (Felton CCS) had State 1600 meter Champ Alejandra Barrientos returning this Fall, and Coach Rob Collins has brought along a group behind her in superb style, with the team improving overall about ten minutes on the team time watch (top five times added up) from last year all the way to a number seven in the entire nation ranking. San Lorenzo Valley has raced to strong wins at the Stanford and Mt. SAC Invitationals. Granada (Livermore NCS) raced to a strong Divisional Sweeps win at Mt. SAC, with Julia Fischer leading the team to a strong Section triumph a week ago. Foothill (Redding No) has a strong veteran group with thirty points in an all-divisional Section Finals run! South Hills

(West Covina SS) and La Canada (SS), the latter the defending State champs, battled in the South, with a young South Hills group breaking the La Canada strangehold on the division lately 48-57 in the area finals run. The teams averaged at 19:30 on a course that runs close to Woodward Park timewise.

Jenny Aldridge (Mara Carrillo, Santa Rosa NCS), the latest star out of the city of Santa Rosa, was fourth individually here last year and the NCS Champ a week ago. Frosh Rocio Ferree (South Hills) took Nicole Bonino (La Canada 5th in State 1998) in the Southern Section run, with Ali Valle (San Luis Obispo) third there. Lauren Gustafson (Mills, Millbrae CCS) was sixth individually last year here.

Boys' action this morning starts with Division II, another of those fun contests with top teams from one end of the state to the other! Eureka was a scary 19 point winner in the North Coast Section, with a top five that gapped within thirty seconds of winner Lehrin Morey! Santiago (Garden Grove SS) emerged mightily from the pack in its section, with an 80:10 team time (16:02) on a course that runs close to Woodward Park. Rene Rangel, Juan Corona, and Rudy Corona ran in the 15:40's for Santiago, with that trio's placing against Eureka's tight five possibly a decisive factor, as Santiago gapped at a minute through five. La Jolla (SD) surprised with a Section win, with Ramona (SD) also pushing highly ranked Scripps Ranch (SD) in front of the TV this weekend instead of here. Ramona leads with Matt McInvale (third here last year), under 15:00 at Mt. SAC earlier this year before slight injury. De la Salle (Concord NC) has been ranked highly all season long, and is a threat here. Barstow (SS) and Villa Park (SS), led by 8:56 3200m runner in Track, Augie Escobar, were two-three out of the Southern Section.

Puneet Mahan (Norwalk SS), Carlos Carballo (Cathedral City SS), Joe Rankin (Monte Vista, Spring Valley SD 6th here last year), Efeson Yosief (San Leandro NCS), Girmay Guangul (Santa Clara CCS), Dawit Gezahgn (Del Mar,

Fall) heading the Rancho Bernardo group (Allison Hall was 16th last Fall for RB here).

The Boys Division IV contest is the most geographically diverse with teams challenging for the title. It will be a wild and wooly contest! McFarland (CE) has been top-ranked all season long, with Coach Jim White's group hoping to add another championship trophy to the school's case. Individual winner, Andres Gomez, led McFarland to the Central title with only 19 points! Ventura county rivals Nordhoff (Ojai SS) and Oak Park (SS) have hammered on each other all Fall, with Nordhoff taking the area title 70-89. Mark Nevers (Oak Park SS) was second at this level statewide last year, with Robert Contreras (Nordhoff SS) third.

Central Valley (Shasta Lake) won the Northern Section overall behind star Steven Springhorn (10th here last year). St. Augustine (San Diego) won the area contest over strong Valley Center (SD), with Ryan Moorcroft (St. Augustine) the individual winner. Estancia (Costa Mesa SS) and Corona del Mar (Newport Beach SS) were 3-4 out of the competitive South, with Piedmont nipping Dublin in the North Coast Section, as Tom Phelps (Piedmont NCS) took the area individual title. The dark horse team of the entire meet is Riverbank (SJ), who won the Sac Joaquin title with 20 points in a fine team time, and appear heading into the end of the season in good health. They started like a house a-fire in 1998, then just had one misfortune after another. We are sure they are interested in more than making up for last year here.

Ryan Hall (Big Bear SS) is hot down south, with a sub 15:00 on the tough Mt. SAC course in recent weeks. Victor Moreno (Escalon SJ) is a sub 9:20 3200m runner in track. Jeff Arnold (St. Francis, La Canada SS) and Billy Nelson (Taft CE) have good big-meet credentials. Jesse McLeod (Lassen, Susanville No) had a fine Section Finals run.

The Girls Division V race is one all out of context with quality of teams compared to school size. There are some great squads at this level who will battle here!! University (San Francisco NCS) has won three consecutive titles at this level, and with Aliza Cohen (3rd place here last year) leading, they will not give up without a fight. From the South come three dynamite groups, with Chadwick (Palos Verdes SS) nipping Northwood (Irvine SS), and Maranatha (Sierra Madre SS) 67-70-73 in their Southern Section area title run! Chadwick leads

with Kristin Cohoon, a top miler in track, with Northwood the nucleus of Irvine High's State Division I Champs from last year who were in the school attendance boundary area when Northwood opened this year. Maranatha leads with super-frosh Laura Meyers, who has run some very impressive times in her first year. Check your uniform colors and sit back to enjoy the action (Uni typically is red and white, Chadwick white and blue, Northwood Blue and White, and Maranatha a patriotic red, white, and blue)!

Clara Horowitz (Head-Royce NCS) is very strong at this level, with Kaili Shumilak (Bishops, La Jolla SD) an impressive Section winner. Jenny Bell (Ontario Christian SS) and Treani Swain (Oakwood, North Hollywood), a fine middle school track age- grouper with sub 54 second (400) and sub 2:10 (800) clockings already (!), are strong from down South. Kelly Moore (Avalon, Catalina Island SS) was fifth at this level last year. Alle Porter (Dunsmuir No) took the overall Section title up north.

It is very fitting to finish the day with the Boys Division I. This level features one of the hottest teams in recent state history, with Coach Don Salyers' Don Lugo (Chino Hills SS) team believing lately in the "scorched earth" policy. The nation's thirteenth ranked team (who should be at least a few spots higher) blasted one of the fastest team times ever on the Mt. SAC course a week ago down south with a 15:35 average on the challenging 2.98 mile course, a run that left the slightly damp course smoking afterwards! Since the Mt. SAC Invitational a month ago the Don Lugo group has been as impressive as any group in recent California history. However, they do have to show up and run today! Clovis (CE), led by JJ Duke (10th last year Div I), is very dangerous at home, with a ton of races on the State Meet course. The San Diego situation has been crazy, with another tie in the Section Finals (there have been four now involving top ranked teams in the Palomar League), ending with Mt. Carmel (SD) and Poway (SD) on to the state meet. Vista earns the award as the highest ranked squad statewide not in our competition, even though it was hoped that a recommendation by the State Track & Cross-Country Advisory Committee a couple of years back to allow ties for the last spot to go to state be acted upon in this situation. Belmont (LA) continued its string of titles in the LA Section. Long Beach Poly (SS), Katella (Anaheim SS), Rialto (SS),

Murrieta Valley (SS), and Sultana (Hesperia SS) all averaged 16:06 or better on a course that runs close to this at Woodward Park in the Southern finals, with this a year where the State Commissioners threw two extra qualifiers at the Southern Section to offset the obscene difference in the sizes of the State's divisions in this sport. Buchanan (Clovis CE), led by Fernando Cabada (13th her last year and sub 9:00 3200m in track) has had a couple of fine races this Fall. Jesuit (Sacramento SJ) moves up to this level with a Sac Joaquin title this Fall.

Oswaldo Pina (Lakewood SS), a sub 9:10 3200m runner in track as a soph last spring, won the Southern Section, with Daniel Mejia (Katella, Anaheim), and Arturo Garcia (Don Lugo, Chino) next. Ryan Bousquet (Esperanza, Anaheim SS) has had some good races this Fall. Travis Laird (San Marcos SD) won the San Diego title over Evan Fox (West Hills, Santee SD), with Humberto Vargas (Belmont, LA) his area winner. Neil Davis (Bellarmine, San Jose CCS) took his Section title.

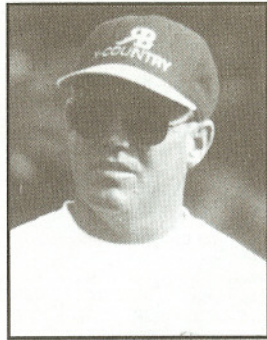
Dan Cruz

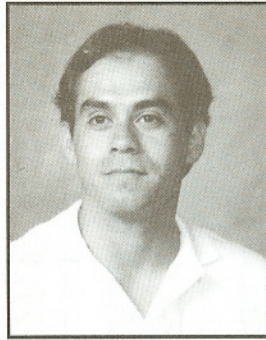
Ron DiMaggio

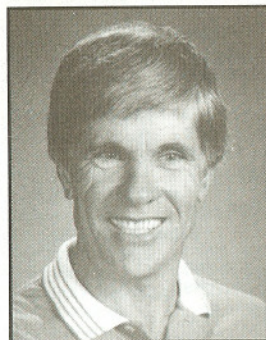
Eduardo Ramos

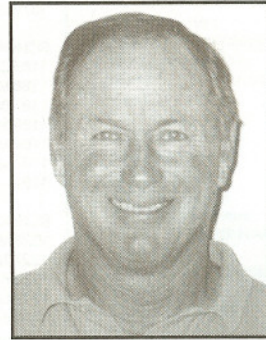
Eddie Salazar

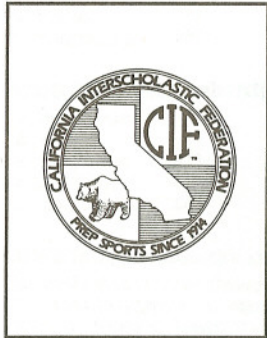


Bill Joseph
