 - Clean up—financial penalty

 - o Athletes warm up on path by course that starts at the toilets
- Arrival/departure etiquette and bus procedures
 - Buses

 - Athletes
 - Stay off driveways and lawns on arrival
 - Wait in Hallmark Park until your ride arrives
 - Don't mill around on the street

Fees Increased

Also \$1 for every spectator for whom we charge admittance (applies to SCVAL championship meet only for our league)
