**Entry Fee Schedule:** Add your total number of runners entered, boys and girls combined. There is a \$375 max.

### The Artichoke Invitational Half Moon Bay October 5, 2019 2.33 miles / 1 HILL

Dear Coaches,

First and foremost, Welcome to Half Moon Bay and thank you for participating in the 2019 Artichoke Invitational! We should be seeing some great races today.

In your envelope, you will find:

\* Race numbers
\* Course maps
\* Pins (get more if you need)
\* Race schedule
\* Trash bag

Some things to remember today:

### 1. VERY IMPORTANT: OUR RACES THIS YEAR ARE VERY LARGE. IT IS ABSOLUTELY VITAL THAT YOUR RUNNERS DO NOT STOP IMMEDIATELY AFTER FINISHING. THEY NEED TO CONTINUE TO MOVE INTO THE CONTAINMENT AREA AND AWAY FROM THE FINISH TO AVOID ANY COLLISIONS.

2. Remind your athletes to report to the start line 10 minutes prior to their scheduled start time. Due to very large fields in the morning races, there will be additional starting lines to spread the field out. The lines will be used as such:

Line 1: First runner Line 2: Second runner Line 3: Third runner Line 4: Fourth and Fifth runner Line 5: Sixth and seventh runner Line 6: All remaining runners

- 3. **Chips**: This is our second year of using chips. Last year, we had a number of chips not returned. Make sure your athletes have their assigned numbers and chips.
- 4. RETURN ALL UNUSED CHIPS. Teams not turning in unused chips will be charged \$10 per chip. I don't want to send you a bill, and you don't want to pay any extra fees. So please turn them in.
- 5. **T shirt sales**, patches and baseball hats, and beanies will be at the top of the bleachers. Make sure you get one. In fact, get 2 or 3! You'll be glad you did.
- 6. **NO DOGS ON CAMPUS**. Inform your parents. They are not allowed. We had multiple dogs issues last year, so please leave them at home. We don't want to call the sheriffs but we will. Thanks for your cooperation.

- 7. We will adhere to the time schedule as closely as possible. We aim to begin all our races on time so we can end on time.
- 8. In the spirit of sportsmanship, please make sure your top athletes are entered as varsity runners.
- 9. The infield of the football field is for first aid and finishing athletes only. **NO** Team tents. We want no confusion should a runner need to seek first aid.

# 10. Remind your athletes to KEEP MOVING THROUGH THE FUNNEL TO THE CORRAL. NO STOPPING RIGHT AFTER THE FINISH. THEY SHOULD NOT LEAVE THE CORRAL UNTIL RETURNING THEIR CHIP.

- 11. Results will be posted on the wall of the bathrooms above the bleacher area.
- 12. Individual and Team Awards will be picked up at the awards table. It is located in the south end zone near the long jump pits. ONLY coaches are permitted to pick up awards.
- 13. The First-aid tent will be located on the south end of the football field.
- 14. The snack bar is at the top of the bleachers. Please partake. Great tacos.
- 15. Do your best to keep our bathrooms as clean as you can for the next person. Nobody ever wants to use a messy bathroom.
- 16. Busses: Please have your drivers drop you at the front of the school and park either in the lower parking lot or down in the Rite-Aid parking lot.
- 17. **NO DOGS ON CAMPUS** (EXTRA REMINDER) Inform your parents. They are not allowed. We had multiple dogs issues last year, so please leave them at home. We don't want to call the sheriffs but we will. Thanks for your cooperation.
- 18. Remind your athletes to KEEP MOVING THROUGH THE FUNNEL TO THE CORRAL. NO STOPPING RIGHT AFTER THE FINISH. THEY SHOULD NOT LEAVE THE CORRAL UNTIL RETURNING THEIR CHIP.
- 19. Have a great meet and come back next year!
