Important Notes

- Entry fee for cars \$6 per car
- No busses can stay onsite during meet due to use of the parking lot for construction equipment rented by the city
- Portable garbage and recycling containers will b placed near the finish and near team areas Please be vigilant about picking up loos e trash so it doesn't blow into the bay
- Do not use the regular trash cans at the park or we may be charged a dumpster fee We are required to pay <u>approx. \$294</u> to a Sunnyvale employee to supervise us. If he/she give you a reasonable order, please comply.
- Vehicles are not allowed off the asphalt roadways or parking lot areas. This includes deliveries and set-up/tear-down vehicles
- No stakes are allowed to be driven into the ground
- No tents are allowed as per the Fire Marshall.
- No small flags may be placed on the course to help guide the runners.
- Portable toilets will be provided for our use at an <u>approx. cost of \$1642.60</u>. This is an increase of approx.\$25. They will be located near the finish line. Regular toilet facilities are located at the park. We should plan not to use them if possible. Coaches should check them every now and then to make sure that we are not making a mess of them if used.
